#### In the name of Allah the Compassionate, the Merciful

#### Introduction

"American imperialism does not exploit its oil reserves and imports petroleum in order to save its own oil for its purposes. The Shah by selling this black gold actually drains the Iranian oil reserves, while he does not spend the petro-dollars for the welfare of needy Iranian people. He either loans money to his imperialist masters or buys destructive weapons in order to protect the imperialists' interests in Iran and the region.

Imam Khomeini March 12, 1975

During the growth of the Islamic movement against the Shah's despotic regime. Imam Khomeini, the great leader of the movement, issued orders for a nationwide strike against the regime. He thus inflicted a blow that paved the way for total collapse.

Imam Khomeini's call for strikes and the general popular obedience to his orders represented a total rejection of the regime by the followers of the Islamic Revolution. The movement initiated, shut-downs weakened the regime and the Bahman 22 (Feb. 11, 1979) revolution ended it; burying the dictator monarch in its own tyrannical history.

In order to comprehend the effects of the strikes on the regime, the economic structure of the monarchy should first be understood, then the effects of the strike would become evident.

The Shah's economic system was an oil dependent economy. Its entire dynamic was thus naturally driven by oil revenues. The history of oil revenues being a part of Iran's national budget goes back to William D'Arcy's original oil contract of the early 1900's. Since the time of the U.S. orchestrated coup of 1953, which was followed by concluding new contracts with the consortium of American, British, Dutch and French oil firms, coinciding with the implementation of planned development projects in Iran, the position of oil revenues vis.a.vis the national budget was being strengthened year by year. Thus the nature of the Iranian economy was being transformed into a single product economy i.e. depending on a single source of income which was oil.

Along with the importance of oil for the progress of the West's economy and its role in economic planning for the western countries, the growth and evolution of oil exploration inside Iran gained momentum to satisfy certain domestic conditions. It was deemed a necessity to increase the public's purchasing power in order to stabilize the regime. Additionally there was a market failure in initiating non-oil dependent economic plans utilizing the national labor force and other natural resources, by the

Shah's regime. Finally steady oil income was a necessity in order to implement American inspired development projects such as the Shah's five year development plans.

A glance at the chart shows the sharp increases in the volume of oil revenues between 1955 & 1977

The chart indicates that the Shah's regime believed that the only way to increase the national budget was to depend on oil revenues. This dependency steadily increased. The subsequent growth in Iran's national budget was a consequence of an increased export of oil. If left unabated the result would have been a serious decline in oil reserves. Although portions of the oil revenue brought prosperity to a small percentage of the Iranian society and increased the purchasing power of lower income groups, the bulk of the petro-dollars were spent on purchasing military equipment, and enriched only those who were collaborating closely with the regime and the internal Businessmen. These petro-dollars also tended to safeguard the interests of the multi-national corporations in Iran.

The introduction of oil revenues as Iran's economic base had within two decades, brought about major economic changes, the central one being Iran's conversion into a single product economy. Despite this vast and growing oil income, the regime still suffered from budget deficit.

Obviously a regime so unbalanced with respect to its economic base, left itself open to abuses which led into unpopularity. The flow of oil was the jugular vein of the regime's economy and the Shah's attachment to peagentary as government fueled by this wealth, soon became vulger exaggeration. Thus when the Islamic movement threatened the export of oil, the regime was placed in mortal danger.

"The Shah and his government have started armed struggle against the Iranian people, the constitution and above all against the liberating Islamic tenets. They are traitors and

following them is to follow unbelief. Do not give them any chance. With strikes and protests inform the whole world about their brutal activities.»

After the tragic carnage of Sept. 17, 1978 (known as Black Friday) the brutal nature of the regime became more apparent, while the strikes were becoming institutionalized. On September 10, 1978, the workers of Tehran's oil refinery initiated the first shutdown of Iran's oil industry. Afterwards, the work stoppages spreaded in all other parts of Iran's oil industries and continued to the extent that oil exports were completly halted.

The nationwide strike actions were major factors which speeded up the downfall of the regime, while causing great anxiety among the pro- U.S. supporters of the Shah's regime.

Besides the effects of the strikes in destabilizing the Shah's regime, the international reprecussions of cutting Iran's oil exports touched off a grave crisis for U.S. officials. In the wake of Washington's apprehensions, the State Department asked its embassy in Tehran to prepare intelligence reports with regard to the oil industry strikes so that American officials could be better kept abreast of new developments.

The documents presented in this volume from the series of books published by the Center for the Publication of the U.S. Espionage Den's Documents represent a collection of these reports compiled from different files.

Besides its historical value, the collection of documents provides the reader much formerly classified information. The documents clearly reveal the deep anxiety of the Americans at that time over the strikes. Their anxiety was due largely to the serious threat that was menacing their economic and political interests, as well as the great emphasis they laid on oil exportation.

Since the documents are basically news reports they do not illustrate or the combasis the Americans had laid on oil exportation. Thus it was decided not to do so in this introduction. But with a glance at the documents, the following points can be seen as major elements of the American anxiety:

- The Shah's regime was the major supplier of petrolena to Israel:
- Western imperialism had designated from the most important protector of U.S. interests in the Persian Gulf region i.e. the gendarme of the Persian Gulf.
  - Iran was a most important market for American arms and goods.
- Iran was considered the strongest balwork for preventing the Physikons having access to the warm waters of the Persian Gult, into two class the proper back in the

Central Treaty Organization (CENTO).

In addition to the above mentioned factors, the effects of strikes in the West itself had created grounds for American, uneasiness. Under these circumstances the U.S. Espionage Center in Tehran became like a newstoom in relation to gathering strike intelligence. In some days scores of pages were despatched to the U.S. State Department.

Studying the documents reveals that the U.S. embassy agents were not reporting or collecting hard news, rather they were conveying the opinions gathered in contact with those Iranian officials who were in charge of the oil industry or who played a major role in suppressing the strikes. The logical conclusion of this reportage is that the U.S. government held the same opinion as the Shah's regime for breaking the strikes. In this relation two important point were outstanding:

1. The embassy staffers repeatedly expressed their dissatisfaction with the Iranian government's attitude towards solving the strike crisis. According to them the government's weak policy would not solve the work stoppages. In the first stage of the strike, their anxiety was over the government's decision to meet the overwhelming majority of the strike's demands. The embassy employees held that such decision making had weakened the government's position.

During the ensuing stages of the strike they believed that the government should coordinate decisive tactics for serious suppression of the strikes. They subsequently complained about the government's policy of vacilation towards the strikes.

2. The strikes were setting lempo for the Islamic revolution's advance. The growing awareness of the strikes and the Muslim Iranian people about the power of the strikes, as well as the reflection of news of the strikes in the Iranian press bothered the U.S. embassy.

U.S. Ambassador William Sullivan on one occasion vaised this issue with Hushang Ansari (the cheif of Iran's national oil company). He said. "The oil company should give proper and correct news of strikes to the press. In this way the flow of false information about the strikers could be prevented." He received a promise from Ansari on this question.

Anyhow, despite all the U.S. and allied imperialist efforts, the mighty power of the strikes continued. When the brutal suppression of the regime, i.e. imprisonment, turture and murder were thought to be slowing down the process of the strikers, Imani Khomeini and the people neutralized the threats of the regime, and the strikes gathered greater momentum.

It was in the first half of the Iranian month of Azar 1357 (Nov. 22- Dec. 22, 1978) two month after the beginning of the strikes, that the Americans realized everything and through their agents discovered the real roots of the strikes: "All our agents

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report that the strike activities in the oil industry are exclusively undertaken by Khomeini's invitation and no single piece of economic logic exists for it.»

Still, the U.S. and its taghooti agents' plots against the oil workers' strikes were not successful. The strikes, one of the most powerful arms of the Islamic Revolution continues pressuring on the shah's regime till the strikers, along with the people; succeeded in overthrowing the regime.

Finally through the efforts of the brave sons of Islam, on February, 11, 1979 the shah's regime was finished and the Islamic Republic was established. With out a doubt the blood of those oil workers martyred in the course of the strikes is a proud heritage for the Muslim Iranian people and especially for their co-workers in the oil industry and a challenge to continue the martyrs' way.

EMBASSY DEFACTION/ COMMENTS ON THESE REPORTS WOULD BE APPRECIATED. END SUMMARY.

2. IGAT PIPELINE EXPLOSION. ACCORDING TO JAPANESE AND U.S. COMPANY OFFICIALS, REPORTED EXPLOSION OCCURRED ON THURSTAY, SEPTEMBER 21, AT POINT IN PIPELINE ROUTE APPROXIMATULY 17 MILES SOUTH OF QUM. BLAST REPORTEDLY DESTROYED FOR FOOT-SECTION OF LARGE DIAMETER PIPELINE. NO CASUALTIES MINITORED, PRESS ITEM QUOTFO UNNAMED NIGC SPOKESMAN AS PLAMING TERROEISTS FOR THE INCIDENT.

1. ON SEPTEMBER 23, THE LOCAL PRESS CARRIED SOMEWHAT CONTRA-DICTORY REPORTS OF AN EXPLOSION ON SEPT. 21 WHICH DESTROYED A SECTION OF THE 42-INCH PIPELINE (IGAT I) WHICH XXXXXXXXXX ABOUT ONE BILLION SCF/DAY OF NATURAL GAS FOR EXPORT TO THE USSR. THE RUPTURE OCCURRED NEAR SAVEH, TO THE NORTH OF OUM.

2. THE EXPLOSION INVOLVED A SEVEN RPT SEVEN METER SECTION OF PIPE ALTHOUGH, DURING THE REPAIRS WHICH WERE COMPLETED IN JUST OVER 48 HOURS, 70 METERS OF PIPE WERE REPLACED. OUR SOURCES AT NIGC MAINTAIN THAT EXPLOSION RESULTED FROM CORROSION AND PIPE STRESS. HOWEVER, IN VIEW OF THE VERY UNUSUAL AMOUNT OF DIFFICULTY WE HAD IN OBTAINING INFORMATION ON EXPLOSION AS WELL AS THE INTENSE LEVEL OF ACTIVITY AT NIGC DURING THE PAST WEEK (INCLUDING, WE UNDERSTAND, A HURRIEDLY SCHEDULED MEETING BETWEEN

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- 3. RECENT RUMORS ABOUT IMMINENT DEPARTURE OF HUSHANG ANSARY (COMMENTED ON IN TEHRAN 8721 AND 8971) HAVE LARGELY SUBSIDED. WE HAVE HEARD THAT ANSARY IS ONE OF THOSE IDENTIFIED BY OPPOSITIONIST GROUPS AS ONE OF MANY IN GOVERNMENT MO WHO WILL HAVE TO GO . - - WHETHER FOR BAHAI CONNECTIONS OR CORRUPTION OR BOTH IS NOT CLEAR ALTHOUGH BOTH ALLEGATIONS HAVE MADE THE RUMOR CIRCUIT. HOWEVER, TEHRAN SUCH RUMORS ARE CIRCULATING IN/ABOUT MANY AND IT IS NOT AT ALL CLEAR THAT ANSARY HAS HAD IT. WE TEND TO DISBELIEVE THE EXISTENCE OF BAHAI CONNECTIONS AND THUS FAR THEPE HAVE BEEN NO PUBLIC CHARGES OF CORRUPTION LEVIED AGAINST ANSARY. HE, AND NIOC, COULD OF COURSE BE CAUGHT UP IN THE ANTI-CORRUPTION DRIVE BUT IT IS A DEVELOPMENT THAT CANNOT BE PREDICTED.
- 4. THE DRIFT AT NIOC COMMENTED UPON IN REFTEL HAS BEEN EVIDENT FOR FAR LONGER THAN THE RUMORS ABOUT & ANSARY'S LIKELY OUSTER. WE BELIEVE THAT THIS DRIFT IS LARGELY A REFLECTION OF (A) THE DEPARTURE IN PEBRUAR: OF NIOC'S TWO BEST AND MOST EXPERIENCED DIRECTORS (MINA AND NABEGE), (B) THE LACK OF REMOTIVE PRACTICAL OIL INPUSTED EXPERIENCE OF ANSARY AND MEHRAN, AND (C) THE DIFFICULTY OF MONING AN ORGANIZATION AS LARGE AND LETHARGIC AS NIOC. PER CONCERN ABOUT PROTECTING ONES SELF : BOM THE POSSIBLETY

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OF AN OFFICIAL INVESTIGATION IS OF COURSE MUCH INCREASED AT PRESENT; AND, AS WE POINTED OUT IN TEHRAN 8971, ANSARY IS PROBABLY EXHIBITING THIS CONCERN. IT SHOULD ALSO BE NOTED, THOUGH, THAT THERE ARE SCORES OF SENIOR AND MIDDLE-LEVEL OFFICIALS OF NIOC (AND OF MANY OTHER GO) ENTITIES) WHO DO NOT RELISH THE PROSPECT OF AN EXTENSIVE INVESTIGATION AND ARE PERFECTLY WILLING TO LET THINGS DRIFT.

5. REPORTS OF STRIKE AFFECTING NIOC/OSCO OPERATIONS. INCLUDING PRODUCTION AND MRR OPERATIONS OF KHARG ISLAND EXPORT TERMINAL, WHICH HAVE BEEN CIRCULATING IN INDUSTRY CIRCLES IN TEHRAN (AND IN U.S. JUDGING FROM REFTEL) HAVE TENDED TO EXAGGERATE PRESENT AND SHORT-TERM IMPACT AND HAVE UNTIL YESTERDAY EXAGGERATED EXTENT OF WALK-OUT. THE STRIKE BEGAN ON SEPT. 23 BY A FAIRLY SMALL NUMBER OF DAILY RATED EMPLOYEES (DRE'S) IN AHWAZ. HOWEVER, IT GRADUALLY SPREAD AND BY YESTERDAY APPROXIMATELY 90 PERCENT OF DRE'S IN AHWAZ, AGHAJARI, GACHSARAN, AND KHARG ISLAND WERE PARTICIPATING IN WALK-OUT. OSCO MANAGEMENT WAS PRESENTED WITH A LIST OF 20 DEMANDS, INCLUDING BOTH SALARY AND FRINGE BENEFITSY. HOWEVER, OSCO HAS TAKEN A REKTIMEKYAR RELATIVELY PASSIVE MORKAROKK ROX ROLE IN SUBSEQUENT NEGOTIATIONS, AND THE PRINCIPAL ACTORS HAVE BEEN THE LABOR MINISTRY, NIOC, SYNDICATES, AND UNOFFICIAL REPS OF THE DRE'S. EVERYTHING WE HAVE

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THEARD INDICATES THAT THE WALK-OUT IS STRICTLY ECONOMICALLY MOTIVATED AND THAT THERE HAVE BEEN NO POLITICAL OVERTONES.

- 6. THERE HAVE BEEN SEVERAL NEGOTIATING MEETINGS BUT THERE HAS BEEN NO EVIDENCE OF PROGRESS. THE MINISTRY OF LABOR AND NIOC HAVE REPORTEDLY TAKEN THE LINE THAT EVERYTHING IS NEGOTIABLE BUT ONLY AFTER THE ILLEGAL STRIKE IS TERMINATED. WE UNDERSTAND THAT GOI NEGOTIA-IXON TORS MADE A VAGUE THREAT YESTERDAY AGAINST DRE'S WHO DID NOT REPORT FOR ESSENTIAL JOBS (INCLUDING ALL JOBS ON KHARG) BY 2:00 P.M. THE SAME DAY--SEPT. 27. REPORTEDLY, A FEW REPORTED TO WORK LATE YESTERDAY AND THIS MORNING BUT COMPLIANCE WITH THE DEMAND TO RESUME WORK HAS BEEN SPOTTY AT BEST.
- 7. IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO PREDICT THE LIKELY OUTCOME, BUT THE STRIKE HAS NIOC AND, REPORTEDLY, THE SHAH VERY NERVOUS; AND, THE WORKERS MAY ACHIEVE MANY OF THEIR GOALS.
- 8. THE WALK-OUT HAS THUS FAR HAD ALMOST NO XDXPAXCEXIMPACT ON KWR PRODUCTION OR EXPORTS. ONE SMALL FIELD (MANSURI WITH A CAPACITY OF 20MB/D) IS SMXMX-IN AS ARE TWO DESALTING PLANTS. AT KHARG, OPERATIONS ARE PROCEEDING NORMALLY. OSCO HAS TWO TUGS UNDER CONTRACT (NOT INVOLVED IN LABOR DISPUTE), IS OPERATING ONE OF ITS OWN TUGS WITH STAFF, AND IS ENGAGING THE SERVICES OF A THIRD KO PRODUCT ION CONTRACT TUG TODAY. 

- 4. HIS JUDGMENT, AS BEFORE, WAS THAT OVERWHELMING MAJORITY OF EMPLOYEES WOULD RETURN TO WORK. HE HAD INSTRUCTED DIBA, HIS DEPUTY IN SOUTH IRAN, TO REHABILITATE OPERATIONS ON UNIT BY UNIT BASI'S. SO FAR, THIS WAS PROCEEDING SMOOTHLY.
- 5. IF THERE WERE EMPLOYEES WHO WERE TO BE DISMISSED,

IPAC AND LAPCO ARE BOTH STILL COMPLETELY SHUT-DOWN BY STRIKES. TOTAL PRODUCTION ON NOVEMBER 4 (INCLUDING OSCO, SIRIP, IMINOCO AND SOFIRAN) WAS ABOUT 1.85 MILLION BBLS.

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2. ACCORDING TO THE LOCAL CONSORTIUM OFFICE, OSCO IS PREDICTING PRODUCTION OF 2.2 MILLION BBLS TODAY. HOWEVER, NEITHER THE LOCAL CONSORTIUM OFFICE NOR THE EMBASSY PLACE MUCH CREDENCE IN THE ESTIMATES WHICH OSCO HAS BEEN MAKING FOR THE PAST 4-5 DAYS.

3. THIS MORNING NIOC CENTRAL OFFICE STAFF JOINED THE STRIKE. THIS ACTION SHOULD NOT HAVE ANY IMPACT ON PRODUCTION, EXPORTS OR REFINING, IN PART BECAUSE THERE ARE SO MANY REDUNDANT STAFF AND IN PART BECAUSE CENTRAL OFFICE STAFF DO NOT HAVE ANY VITAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR BASIC OPERATIONS. HOWEVER, THE ACTION IS IMPORTANT IN A SYMBOLIC WAY, ESPECIALLY SINCE THE CENTRAL OFFICE STAFF HAVE BEEN MUCH LESS POLITICIZED THAN THEIR COLLEAGUES IN

4. THERE HAS ALSO BEEN A RESUMPTION OF THE STRIKE BY EMPLOYEES OF THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM IN TEHRAN WHICH HAS SEVERELY REDUCED THE FLOW OF PRODUCTS FROM THE TEHRAN REFINERY TO RETAIL OUTLETS. CONSEQUENTLY, LONG LINES HAVE FORMED AT THE GAS STATIONS. ON THE BRIGHTER SIDE--THE NOTORIOUS TEHRAN TRAFFIC IS MUCH REDUCED AS MOTORISTS ARE APPARENTLY CONSERVING WHAT FUEL THEY HAVE.

5. WE HAVE BEEN UNABLE THUS FAR TO OBTAIN RELIABLE INFORMATION ON THE CURRENT STATUS OF THE VARIOUS IRANIAN REFINERIES. REPORTEDLY THOSE AT SHIRAZ AND TABRIZ ARE SHUT DOWN, WHILE ABADAN'S THROUGHPUT IS ONLY 200,000

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B/D. I.E. ONE-THIRD OF CAPACITY. TEHRAN REFINERY IS WORKING BUT THROUGHPUT COULD CONCEIVABLY HAVE TO BE REDUCED IF THE INTERRUPTION IN THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM CONTINUES.

6.%. IN SUMMARY, THE SITUATION APPEARS TO BE SLOWLY BUT GRADUALLY DETERIORATING: AND OSCO NOR NIOC HAVE FEW IF ANY MORE QUALIFIED PERSONNEL TO MOVE INTO NEW TROUBLE SPOTS. 1. PRODUCTION LEVELS ARE UP AGAIN TODAY, FOR THE SECOND DAY IN SUCCESSION. OSCO IS SCHEDULED TO PRODUCE 1,661,000 BARRELS, OF WHICH 459,000 BARRELS WILL BE DELIVERED TO DOMESTIC REFINERIES AND 1,202,000 BARRELS WILL BE AVAIL-ABLE FOR EXPORT AS CRUDE. WE UNDERSTAND THAT THE FOUR OFF-SHORE JOINT VENTURES ARE STILL COMPLETELY SHUT DOWN.

2. ACCORDING TO THE LOCAL CONSORTIUM REPRESENTATIVE,

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STRIKING PERSONNEL ARE STILL NOT RETURNING TO WORK AND H/C:RMBasippn 🖟 F/C:JLME11 DCM CWN

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THE GAINS IN PRODUCTION ARE LARGELY A REFLECTION OF THE EFFORTS OF THE IRANIAN NAVY PERSONNEL WHO HAVE BEEN PRESSED INTO SERVICE IN THE FIELDS.

- 3. HOWEVER, IN A MEETING HELD YESTERDAY, WHICH WAS CHAIRED BY THE NEW PRIME MINISTER, THE GOI DECIDED UPON A MMM COURSE OF ACTION DESIGNED TO BREAK THE STRIKE. STRIKING OIL FIELD WORKERS ARE BEING TOLD TODAY THAT I THEY X WILL BE FIRED AND EVICTED FROM COMPANY PROVIDED HOUSING IF THEY DO NOT PESUME WORK. THE DEADLINE FOR SHIFT WORKERS IS TOMORROW AFTERNOOM (11 NOV.) WHILE ALL OTHERS MUST RETURN TO WORK SUNDAY MORNING OR FACE THE CONSEQUENCES.
- 4. WE BELIEVE THAT THE VAST MAJORITY OF WORKERS WILL END THEIR STRIKE IF THEY ARE CONVINCED THAT THE GOVERN-MENT WILL CARRY OUT ITS THREAT. HOWEVER, EVEN A RELA-TIVELY SMALL NUMBER OF HIGHLY RADICALIZED WORKERS COULD CREATE SERIOUS PROBLEMS IF THEY ARE NOT EFFECTIVELY ISOLATED FROM OTHER WORKERS AND IF THEY ARE NOT DENIED ACCESS TO OIL FIELD INSTALLATIONS. WE ARE OBVIOUSLY FOLLOWING DEVELOPMENTS CLOSELY AND WE SHOULD HAVE SOME INDICATION TOMORROW OF WHAT THE STRIKERS' RESPONSE WILL BE TO THE NEW ULTIMATUM.

FOR SHIFT WORKERS AND THIS MORNING FOR ALL OTHERS) WHICH WAS PART OF THE GOI'S ULTIMATUM TO STRIKING OIL FIELD

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WORKERS THERE HAS BEEN NO WIDESPREAD RETURN TO WORK. THE PRODUCTION GAINS NOTED IN PARA 1 ARE STILL LARGELY ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE USE OF NAVY PERSONNEL; BUT THESE GAINS, WELCOME THOUGH THEY ARE, ARE SMALL AND IT WOULD BE MONTHS (AT LEAST) BEFORE SUFFICIENT NUMBERS OF MILITARY PERSONNEL COULD BE TRAINED WELL ENOUGH TO EF-FECTIVELY REPLACE ALL STRIKERS.

3. THE SITUATION IN AHWAZ AND THE FIELDS IS REPORTEDLY EXTREMELY TENSE. ACCORDING TO THE LOCAL CONSORTIUM REPRESENTATIVE (WHO OBTAINED THE INFORMATION FROM THE MANAGING DIRECTOR OF OSCO) TWO PEOPLE (APPARENTLY TRANTAN) WERE KILLED IN AHWAZ YESTERDAY BY MARTIAL LAW AUTHORITIES, THERE WAS SHOOTING IN GACHSARAN YESTERDAY (NO INFORMATION AVAILABLE ABOUT POSSIBLE INJURIES OR DEATHS). THE HOME OF AN EXPATRIATE EMPLOYEE (MATIONALITY UNKNOWN) OF OSCO IN AHWAZ WAS RANSACKED YESTERDAY BY A MOB (NO PERSONAL INJURY), PAMPHLETS ARE CIRCULATING WIDELY IN THE SOUTH WHICH PLEDGE TOTAL SUPPORT OF THE ISLAMIC CLERGY FOR THE OIL STRIKE, MORALE OF OSCO EX-PATRIATES IS SUFFERING, AND SERIOUS THOUGHT IS BEING GIVEN TO EVACUATION OF THE FAMILIES OF OSCO EXPATRIATES.

4. SINCE THE GOVERNMENT'S THREAT OF DISMISSAL AND EVICTION FROM COMPANY PROVIDED HOUSING DID NOT SUCCEED IN BREAKING THE STRIKE, THE GOI HAS ALREADY BEGUN TAKING STRONGER ACTION. WE ARE RELIABLY INFORMED THAT 170

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OIL FIELD WORKERS HAVE BEEN ARRESTED SINCE YESTERDAY.

NEARLY 100 PERCENT OF THE SENIOR AND SUPERVISORY STAFF ARE WORKING WHILE NEARLY ALL OF THE STAFF WITH LESS THAN 5 YEARS EXPERIENCE (WHICH COMPRISES ABOUT 60 PERCENT OF THE STAFF CORPS) OFFICE PHEASH IN THE PROPERTY OF THE PROPERTY

- 3. OSCO IS CONTINUING TO CONSIDER EVACUATION OF EX-PATRIATE DEPENDENTS BUT A DECISION DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE IMMINENT.
- 4. WE ESTIMATE THAT IRAN'S GROSS FOREIGN EXCHANGE

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EARNINGS FROM THE EXPORT OF OIL WILL BE, AS A RESULT OF THE EFFECTS OF THE STRIKE THROUGH MIDNIGHT NOV. 12. NEARLY 900 MILLION DOLLARS LESS THAN THEY WOULD HAVE BEEN IN THE ABSENCE OF LABOR DIFFICULTIES. OUR ESTI-MATE ASSUMES THAT IRANIAN CRUDE PRODUCTION WOULD HAVE BEEN 6.3 MILLION B/D DURING THE LAST THREE WEEKS -- A REASONABLE ASSUMPTION WE BELIEVE SINCE PRODUCTION AVERAGED 6.1 MILLION B/D DURING THE IRANIAN MONTH ENDED OCT. 22 AND SINCE DEMAND WAS INCREASING. THE LOSS IS ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE STRIKE CAUSED REDUCTION/OF 11 MILLION BARRELS BY THE FOUR OFFSHORE JOINT VENTURE PRODUCERS AND 60 MILLION BARRELS BY OSCO, ALL OF WHICH WOULD HAVE BEEN EXPORTED. ADDITIONALLY, EVEN IF THE STRIKE WERE ENDED TODAY, PRODUCTION WOULD NOT REACH THE 6.3 MILLION B/D LEVEL FOR AT LEAST 10 DAYS AND DURING THAT TIME IRAN WOULD INCUR AN ADDITIONAL OTE LOSS UNOTE OF FOREIGN EXCHANGE EARNINGS OF NEARLY 100 MILLION DOLLARS. PART OF THAT RESISTANCE HAS ALWAYS BEEN RELATED TO THE WIDESPREAD BELIEF THAT IT WAS QTE SAFER UNQTE TO BUY FROM A MULTINATIONAL OIL COMPANY WHICH HAS ACCESS TO VARIOUS CRUDE STREAMS. SUCH A CONSIDERATION WILL PRO-BABLY ASSUME MORE IMPORTANCE IN THE FUTURE, AND NICC WILL FIND IT DIFFICULT TO EFFECTIVELY REBUT. MIOC COULD PER-HAPS HAVE ATTEMPTED TO USE ITS GOOD OFFICES WITH SOME OF ITS OPEC COLLEAGUES IN ORDER TO OBTAIN FOR NIOC CUSTOMERS PREFERENTIAL ACCESS TO CRUDE LIFTINGS FROM SAUDI ARABIA, KUWAIT, ETC. HOWEVER, WE HAVENO NO INFOR-MATION WHICH WOULD SUGGEST THAT IRAN HAS BEEN IN CONTACT WITH OTHER OIL PRODUCERS REGARDING THE PROBLEMS CAUSED BY THE IRANIAN STRIKE, AND IT IS OUR DISTINCT IMPRESSION THAT NIOC CUSTOMERS ARE OTE ON THEIR OWN UNOTE IN PEGARD TO FINDING CRUDE TO REPLACE THAT LOST FROM IRAN. NIOC PROBABLY EXPECTS THAT THE MILITARY WILL SUCCEED IN BREAK-ING THE OIL STRIKE QUICKLY AND THAT ITS CUSTOMERS WILL NOT ATTEMPT TO SIGN UP LONG-TERM CONTRACTS ELSEWHERE. THAT MAY BE AN OVERLY SANGUINE VIEW AND, IF SO, NIOC M MAY BE PUSHING BARTER AND PARALLEL PURCHASE AGREEMENTS WITH GREAT VIGOR NEXT YEAR.

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EMPLOYEES HAVE RESUMED WORK AND MORE ARE STILL RETURNING. THE ONLY IMPORTANT PROBLEMS ARE AT MARUN AND AGHA  $\mathsf{J} \mathbb{R} \mathsf{I}$ FIELDS WHERE PRODUCTION IS STILL LIMITED BY THE SHORTAGE OF WORKERS. OSCO PLANS ON BRINGING ONE NGL PLANT (OF SIX) BACK ON STREAM TODAY.

- 3. LAPCO STARTED BRINGING ITS SASSAN FIELD BACK INTO PRODUCTION LATE YESTERDAY AFTERNOON, NOVEMBER 13, AND BY MIDNIGHT PRODUCTION WAS UP TO A RATE OF 205,000 B/D. ALL LAPCO STRIKERS HAVE RESUMED WORK.
- 4. IMINOCO STARTED PRODUCTION LATE YESTERDAY AFTERNOON AND WE UNDERSTAND THAT THEY ARE NOW PRODUCING AT A RATE OF 45-50,000 B/D. APPARENTLY, ALL STRIKERS HAVE RETURNED TO WORK.
- 5. ACCORDING TO A KNOWLEDGEABLE NIOC SOURCE, SIRIP WAS SUPPOSED TO HAVE RESUMED PRODUCTION AT 0700 THIS MORNING. WE HAVE NOT YET GOTTEN AUTHORATIVE CONFIRMA-TION, BUT WE ASSUME THAT SIRIP WILL BE PRODUCING 45-50,000 B/D BY THIS EVENING.
- 6. IPAC BEGAN BRINGING ITS DARIUS FIELD BACK INTO PRODUCTION YESTERDAY AFTERNOON BUT PROGRESS HAS BEEN SLOW. IPAC PERSONNEL ON KHARG ISLAND HAVE RESUMED WORK BUT MOST OF THE PERSONNEL ON IPAC'S OFFSHORE PRODUCTION AND FACILITIES PLATFORMS ARE STILL RE- $_{
  m i}$ FUSING TO END THEIR STRIKE, APPARENTLY, THE OFFSHORE

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PERSONNEL EITHER HAVE NOT HEARD OR DO NOT BELIEVE THAT THE BULK OF THEIR COLLEAGUES HAVE RESUMED WORK.

- 7. TOTAL IRANIAN PRODUCTION TODAY SHOULD BE 3.3 MILLION BBLS., 2.8 MILLION BBLS OF WHICH WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR EXPORT.
- 8. WE HAVE BEEN INFORMED BY THE PUBLIC RELATIONS DIRECTOR OF NIOC THAT THE "STRIKERS COMM'TTEE" AT ABADAN REFINERY HAS ISSUED A DECLARATION THAT THEY ARE ENDING THEIR STRIKE SINCE THE SHAH HAS PROMISED TO MEET THEIR POLITICAL DEMANDS. APPARENTLY THE ABADAN REFINERY STAFF HAVE FORGOTTEN THEIR CALLS FOR ABROGA-TION OF ALL OIL AGREEMENTS AND THE DISMISSAL OF ALL FOREIGNERS IN THE OIL INDUSTRY AND ARE BANKING ON THE FUTURE RELEASE OF ALL POLITICAL PRISONERS AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A GOVERNMENT SUBSTANTIALLY INDEPENDENT OF THE SHAH.
- 9. THE PROGRESS OF THE LAST 2-3 DAYS IS MOST WELCOME AND OPTIMISM IS GROWING. HOWEVER, SIGNIFICANT NUMBERS

OF OSCO EMPLOYEES ARE STILL NOT WORKING AND THEY MAY BE BECOMING INCREASINGLY FRUSTRATED OVER THE PRESENT TREND.

WE ARE NOT CERTAIN WHETHER THIS NEWS IS THE RESULT OF CONFUSION OVER THE ANNOUNCEMENT YESTERDAY BY ABADAN REFINERY WORKERS THAT THEY HAD ENDED THEIR STRIKE OR WHETHER NIOC HAS ADOPTED A POLICY OF DISINFORMATION. IN ANY CASE, SIGNIFICANT NUMBERS OF

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OIL FIELD WORKERS OF IPAC AND OSCO ARE STILL NOT WORKING. THE STRIKES, AS WE REPORTED YESTERDAY, AGAINST LAPCO, SIRIP AND IMINOCO HAVE ENDED, AT LEAST TEMPORARILY. THE STRIKES BY NIOC REFINERY PERSONNEL SEEM TO HAVE BEEN RESOLVED AND THROUGH-PUT IS EXPECTED TO BE UP SUBSTANTIALLY TODAY. - 4. OSCO STAFF, BOTH EXPATRIATE AND THE IRANIANS WHO ARE WORKING, ARE CONTINUING TO RECEIVE THREATS. WE HAVE HEARD OF NO SERIOUS INCIDENTS SINCE THE FIRE BOMB ATTACK TWO DAYS AGO AGAINST THE CAR IN WHICH OSCO'S MANAGING

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DIRECTOR WAS RIDING. HOWEVER, TENSIONS ARE STILL VERY HIGH. IN AN ATTEMPT TO PREVENT FURTHER ATTACKS ON OSCO PERSONNEL AND THEIR HOMES, THE MARTIAL LAW AUTHORITIES HAVE MOVED FORCES INTO AND HAVE ESTABLISHED MILITARY COMMAND POSTS IN OSCO RESIDENTIAL AREAS.

- 5. THE SITUATION WITH IPAC IS UNCHANGED FROM YEST-CRDAY. PRODUCTION IS NO MORE THAN A TRICKLE AND THE OFFSHORE PERSONNEL ARE STILL REFUSING TO GO TO WORK. AMOCO OFFICIALS BELIEVE THAT MILITARY FORCES MAY HAVE TO FLY TO AT LEAST SOME OF IPAC'S OFFSHORE PLATFORMS AND BEGIN ARRESTING STRIKE LEADERS IN ORDER TO BREAK THE STAND-OFF.

2. ALTHOUGH PRODUCTION AND EXPORTS ARE GOING WELL NIOC CONTINUES TO HAVE SERIOUS PROBLEMS. THE REFINERIES IN ABADAN, KERMANSHAH AND TABRIZ ARE OPERATING NORMALLY AND THE FIRST TRAIN OF THE NEW ISFAHAN REFINERY HAS BEEN COMMISSIONED AND IS WORKING. HOWEVER. OF WHICH 728.000 WILL BE DELIVERED TO DOMESTIC REFINERIES OF WHICH YER DOW WILL BE DELIVERED TO DOMESTIC REFIRENCES AND 1,786,000 WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR EFFORT. IPAC, LAPOO, AND IMINOCO ARE STILL SHUT-DOWN AND OUR SOURCES GIVE US NO REASON FOR OPTIMISM. SIRIP, NIOC AND SOFIRAN ARE FROLUCING ABOUT 90,200 B/D, BUT MANY SOFIRAN EMPLOYEES FRE TEREATENING TO GO ON STRIKE. SUCH A DEVELOPMENT IS IMPORTANT ONLY IN A PSYCHOLOGICAL SENSE SINCE SOFIRAN PRODUCTION IS ONLY ABOUT 30.000 B/D.
- 2. OSCO ATTEMPTED YESTERDAY TO RE-COMMISSION NGL 600 AT AHWAZ IN ORDER TO RESUME NATURAL GAS DELIVERIES TO IGAT-I PIPELINE. A CREW WAS ASSEMBLED AND DISPATCHED, WITH GREAT EFFORT AND DIFFICULTY, TO THE NGL PLANT LATE YESTERDAY AFTERNOON BUT BEFORE THE PLANT COULD BE BROUGHT UN-STREAM THERE WAS A POWER FAILURE (ELECTRICITY IS PROVIDED BY THE KHUZESTAN WATER AND POWER CORPORATION).

1. PAUL GRIM, OSCO'S GENERAL MANAGER FOR OPERATIONS, AND AN TRANTAN AREA DRILLING SUPERINTENDENT EMPLOYED BY OSCO WERE MURDERED IN SEPARATE INCIDENTS IN AFKAZ ABOUT 3730 DECEMBER 23. GRIM WAS AN AMOUT ON LOAN TO OSCO FROM TEXACO. ACCORDING TO OUR INFORMATION GRIM WAS KILLED BY TEXAGO. ACCORDING TO OUR INFORMATION ONLY ALONS, ONTO THE AUTOMATIC RIFLE FIRE AS HE WAS FRIVING ALONS, ONTO THE MASJED-E-SULIMAN HIGHWAY (A MAIN ROAD LEADING INTO AHMAZ) ON HIS WAY TO WORK. THE TRANIAN OSCO EMPLOYEE WAS REPORT-EDLY KILLED IN FRONT OF HIS HOUSE AS HE WAS PREPARING TO DEPART FOR OSCO OFFICES.

2. IRONICALLY, GRIM WAS THE EMBASSY'S PRIMARY SOURCE FOR PARA 4 OF OUR OIL SECTOR REPORT OF DECEMBER 14 (TERRAN 12254) IN WHICH WE REPORTED THAT EXPERIENCED, LEVEL-HEADED ANERICAN OFFICIALS OF OSCO WERE CONVINCED THAT STRIKERS' THREATS TO TURN TO VIOLENT TACTICS WERE SERIOUS.

WE HAVE CONFIRMED REPORT FERTOL CONCERNING SABOTAGE TO CRUEN SUPPLING, HOW-FYER, LOCAL CONSERVEM REFRESENTATIVE IS ON VACATION AND FIG DAILYS DID NOT KNOW OF INCIDENC. THE LEFSTY CONSERVEM SHEEKSYNTAYIVE ALSO HAD NOT HEART OF MASS-ESSIGNATION LETTER (REFTEL) AND WE HAVE BEEN UNABLE THUS FAR TO OBTAIN ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.

EVEN BEFORE THIS CURRENT ROUND OF INCIDENTS, OIL FIELD STRIKERS HAD BEEN HARDENING THEIR ATTITUDES. LAPCO STRIKERS HAVE FEEN SAYING THAT THEY MIGHT RETURN TO WORK ON DECEMBER 26 BUT THAT THEY MIGHT ALSO DECIDE TO CONTINUE THEIR STRIKE UNTIL THERE IS A CIVILIAN GOVERNMENT.
