We have no objection to your making the information in the attached memorandum available to the official Chilean Service provided this Bureau is not revealed as the source of the information and the assessment set forth in the last two paragraphs of the memorandum.

NOTE:

Classified "Secret-No Foreign Dissemination" because it contains information so classified by CIA (S)(U)

CIA advised that an official Chilean Service requested data on the subject, a Cuban exile residing in Miami. Subject wrote letter to the President of the Chilean Junta requesting data from the Chilean Government which he could use in talks before U. S. businessmen. CIA requested information on the current activities of the subject and a brief assessment of him with an indication of what could be passed to the Chilean Service. It is noted we have previously furnished information to CIA concerning the subject. (U)

The 11/18/74 memorandum notes that subject is the younger brother of Pedro Luis Diaz Lanz, the latter having been head of the Cuban Air Force under Castro in early 1959. Subject was Inspector General of the Cuban Air Force during the same period. Both defected from the

1. ^(S) AN OFFICIAL CHILEAN SERVICE HAS REQUESTED INFORMATION ON MARCOS DIAZ LANZ, A CUBAN EXILE LIVING IN MIAMI, FLORIDA. DIAZ WROTE A LETTER TO GENERAL AUGUSTO PINOCHET, PRESIDENT OF THE CHILEAN JUNTA, IN GUARDED LANGUAGE REQUESTING DATA ON THE GOVERNMENT OF CHILE WHICH HE COULD USE IN A SERIES OF TALKS BEFORE POWERFUL U.S. BUSINESSMEN. THE LETTER IMPLIES THAT DIAZ IS IMPORTANT BUT PROVIDES NO DATA. GENERAL PINOCHET WOULD LIKE INFORMATION ON DIAZ.

2. THE FILES OF THIS AGENCY REFLECT THAT MARCOS DIAZ LANZ, BORN MAY 20, 1928, HAVANA, CUBA, ALIEN REGISTRATION NUMBER A-1188113D, WAS EMPLOYED IN APRIL 1974 AT S.D. BRULL AND ASSOCIATES, 2299 S.W. 27TH AVENUE, MIAMI, FLORIDA. A SOURCE WHOSE INFORMATION HAS PROVEN ACCURATE REPORTED THAT IN NOVEMBER 1964 DIAZ WAS OPERATING AS AN ARMS DEALER UNDER THE ALIAS "PEDRO GARCIA" AND WAS A MEMBER OF AN ULTRA-RIGHTIST GROUP CALLED "MINUTEMEN" IN YALAHA, FLORIDA. (THIS REPORT WAS PASSED TO YOUR REPRESENTATIVE IN MIAMI ON 4 NOVEMBER 1964.)

3. INFORMATION FROM YOUR FILES IS REQUESTED ON THE CURRENT ACTIVITIES AND A BRIEF ASSESSMENT OF MARCOS DIAZ LANZ [WITH AN INDICATION OF WHAT MAY BE PASSED TO THE CHILEAN SERVICE.] (S)
