The following is taken from a memorandum to [redacted] dated 11 January 1953:

9. N-allyl morphine hydrochloride, C<sub>17</sub>H<sub>21</sub>NO<sub>3</sub>, has been reported by [redacted] as an effective analgesic agent, and has a respiratory stimulating effect against respiratory depression caused by morphine, Methadone, Dilaudid, Uramoran, Pentopen, Demoral, Codeine, Nolepon, and Ilisental. It does not counteract non-narcotic agents. It is reported to be effective against lethal overdosage of the narcotics which might be used by some foreign countries. It is not effective against fatal doses of depressants of the central nervous, respiratory or circulatory systems due to drugs other than the narcotics.
