1. The Foreign Materials Information and Samples project is the Agency's current effort directed toward the acquisition of information on new drugs of interest and has been made a part of a similar effort carried on by the Industry Liaison Office of the Edgewood Arsenal Research Laboratories, U. S. Army (EARL, U. S. Army), Edgewood, Maryland. Information derived from this activity has not contributed as significantly as expected to the Agency's Behavioral Activities goals. To provide the broader base needed for this project, it is desired to transfer a portion of this effort to Dr. [REDACTED]

2. Information on new drugs and chemicals having unusual behavioral effects on man is collected by Dr. [REDACTED] through an extensive series of associations established over many years with United States chemical, drug, and other research firms. Through these associations information and samples are obtained on a privileged basis. Information obtained from these sources will be provided to the Agency to service its intelligence and Behavioral Activities requirements. Dr. [REDACTED] will also provide assistance in screening and testing of selected new drugs and chemicals of interest.

3. The proposed support of Dr. [REDACTED] has been coordinated with and agreed to by [REDACTED] and Dr. [REDACTED]

4. It is expected that this joint effort will considerably extend Agency coverage of developments in behavioral pharmacology and will improve its ability to evaluate items of interest. If this initial effort proves to be of mutual benefit, continued support at the same level can be expected.

5. Agency association will be classified CONFIDENTIAL. The work and reports will be UNCLASSIFIED. Dr. [REDACTED] extension [REDACTED] will be the Project Officer and will monitor its execution.
