On 12/20/54, 12/31/54, and 1/3/55 the matter of the disposition of the exhibits in the perjury trial of ALGER HISS was discussed with AUSA ARNOLD BAUMAN, Chief of the Criminal Division, and AUSA GEORGE BAILEY, SDNY.

It was pointed out to Messrs. BAUMAN and BAILEY that there are presently in the custody of the USA, SDNY 388 exhibits in instant case, which exhibits might generally be classified as follows:

1. Exhibits marked in evidence at the first or second trial of HISS.
2. Exhibits marked for identification but not received in evidence at either trial.
3. A miscellaneous assortment of exhibits not marked or received in evidence but which were available or used in the course of the trial for purposes of cross-examination or reference.

At the conclusion of these conferences, Mr. BAUMAN and Mr. BAILEY expressed the belief that all the exhibits in the instant case remain intact and expressed a desire to retain them in the office of the USA. They pointed out that together with these exhibits there were numerous papers, legal and otherwise, relating to the HISS case retained in the files of the USA, and for reasons which will be pointed out hereafter they felt these papers and exhibits should be retained together.

Mr. BAUMAN pointed out that while he did not know it to be a fact, various newspaper items have indicated that HISS was contemplating writing a book, and newspaper articles have likewise indicated that HISS might be called before some legislative committee. In either of these cases HISS might

contradict documentary material and the office of the USA might be called upon to explain this contradiction. If the exhibits in instant matter were to be returned from whence they were procured or otherwise disposed of, considerable difficulty might ensue in obtaining them to properly answer any allegations made by HISS.

In accordance with Mr. BAUMAN's request, SA JOHN J. DANAHY of this office has discussed with AUSA GEORGE BAILEY the nature and location of these exhibits which are filed in individual numbered envelopes. A photostatic copy of a chart together with an index thereof, prepared by SA DANAHY for the HISS trials, is being furnished to the office of the USA for their assistance in locating any of these exhibits which they desire and for the completion of their records.

A photostatic copy of this chart is being furnished to the Bureau so that the Bureau can be aware of the exhibits which are being retained by the USA, SDNY. The original of this chart will be made an exhibit in the files of the NYO.

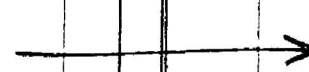

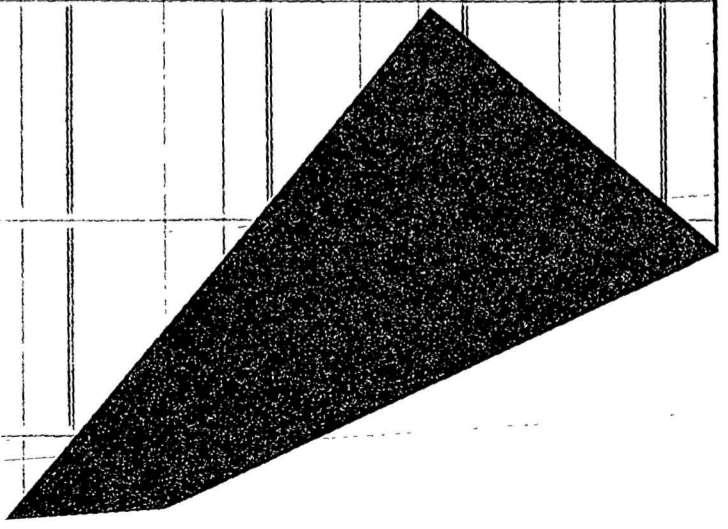
