This is in response to your request dated 13 September 2017 and received by the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) on 14 September 2017. Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), you requested a copy of "the last 10 entries/articles of the NRO blog VIGILANCE FROM ABOVE, as published by the NRO Office of Strategic communication".

We have processed your request in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. A thorough search of our files and databases located nine pages of information responsive to your request. These pages are being released to you in part. Please note that there have been no postings to the VIGILANCE FROM ABOVE blog for a number of years.

Material withheld from release is denied pursuant to FOIA exemptions (b)(1), as properly classified information under Executive Order 13526, Sections 1.4(c) and 1.4(g); and (b)(3), which is the basis for withholding information exempt from disclosure by statute. The relevant withholding statute is 10 U.S.C. § 424, which provides (except as required by the President or for information provided to Congress), that no provision of law shall be construed to require the disclosure of the organization or any function of the NRO; the number of persons employed by or assigned or detailed to the NRO; or the name or official title, occupational series, grade, or salary of any such person.

You have the right to appeal this determination to the NRO Appellate Authority, 14675 Lee Road, Chantilly, VA 20151-1715, within 90 days of the above date. You may also submit an appeal electronically by completing the form available on the NRO's public web site at <a href="http://www.nro.gov/foia/">http://www.nro.gov/foia/</a> AppealInput.aspx. Please include an explanation of the reason(s) for your appeal as part of your submission.
