Justification (if submitted within 48hrs of execution): BN LEVEL DELIBERATE CLEARANCE From recent INTEL, the Al-Amin area has increased with IED/EFP activities, 7th St with the most activities occurred. Previous SIGACTS IVO 7th St, was an RPG/SAF attack on CF when conducting patrols, a possible IED and an IED attack.

TACTICAL AVIATION COORDINATION REQUIREMENTS

Supported Unit Mission Statement: 2-16 IN deliberate clearing operations between 5th street and 8th street on 120600JUL07 IOT allow CF freedom of movement along all routes in AO Ranger.

Supported Unit Summarized Scheme of Maneuver:

Phase II – Movement: Companies and NPs move from COPs/FOB to Assault positions. Company D occupies blocking positions and companies occupy attack positions. Once Companies have linked up with NP and are set to LD the phase is over.

Phase III – Clearance: Companies will clear from south to north. TPT will broadcast the message of what we are doing and why we are here. Units will clear their objectives. Upon contact units will clear the areas around the site and detain MAM for further TQ at FOB Wash site. Once all of the in route objectives have been cleared Phase III is complete.

Phase IV – Exit: This phase will begin once the Companies have completed their missions and have 100% accountability. This phase is complete when all the companies have returned to their COPs/FOB.
