Horatiu Comănciu, leader of one faction of the Rumanian Iron Guard who is presently in Paris, has requested Grigore Niculescu-Buzesti, leader of the National Peasant Party abroad and a member of the new Rumanian Committee, to agree to the appointment of a member of his faction to the new committee. Niculescu-Buzesti has rejected the request.

Comment: Horatiu Comănciu approached Iulian Maniu in 1942, stating that collaboration with the Germans had proved unsatisfactory. Although Comănciu and his group did not leave the Iron Guard, they thereafter cooperated generally with the National Peasant Party.
