Several have been given work with Spanish newspapers and one physician who is a member of the Guard is permitted to practice medicine. Iron Guardists in Spain are supported by the Falange, the Army and Church circles. Prat y Soutso, former Spanish Minister to Bucharest, is largely responsible for Spanish support of the Iron Guard.
