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FOREWORD

(U) The Strategic Air Command (SAC) Historian (HO) requested this chronology by not later than 16 November 1973. If the approximate two-week deadline was not enough challenge, the undersigned being away from this headquarters on a staff assistance visit, 23 through 26 October, further complicated the task. In those most critical days of the contingency, many valuable documents were hurriedly consigned to flame or shredder as the action agencies used them.

(U) Although the undersigned had provided for retention of the documents covering tanker support, occurring before 25 October, the increased readiness posture of 25-26 October was not anticipated. Its coverage is totally dependent upon two history-minded individuals: Lieutenant Colonel D. A. Knight (Operations Plans Division), who provided a copy of the Sequence of Events BOJOs, and Lieutenant Colonel J. K. Enright (Logistics Plans Division), who kept the Logistics Readiness Center Log.

(U) The keystone of the Coronet East coverage is the file of the same name, maintained by Lieutenant Colonel H. B. Wasserman and Major F. L. Petrie (Operations Division, Directorate of Operations and Training). A valuable source on the initial reconstitution at Barksdale and Robins was Captain R. L. Linhardt's (Logistics Plans Division) Reconstitution Briefing. Lieutenant Colonel G. A. Miller and Mr. E. W. Doubleday (Comptroller Office) were helpful in providing available cost data.

(U) Administrative assistance should be acknowledged: TSgt E. A. Kelly (Operations Division), SSgt Aaron Pryor (Logistics Plans Division), and SSgt J. W. Hamilton (Logistics Plans Division).

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- 6-11 October 1973 (U) ~~(S)~~ Egyptian and Syrian forces attacked Israel and another Middle East war began. Israeli aircraft encountered Soviet-made SA-6 surface-to-air missiles (SAMs) and began to sustain heavy losses. (1)
- 11 October (U) ~~(S)~~ Headquarters United States Air Force (USAF) directed selected air bases, including Barksdale Air Force Base (AFB), Louisiana, and Griffiss AFB, New York, to provide storage, safety, security, and assistance in air loading U. S. Army ordnance items for shipment to Israel. Barksdale and Griffiss were Second Air Force bases. (2)
- 12 October (U) ~~(S)~~ Headquarters Strategic Air Command (SAC) advised two other Second Air Force Bases, Blytheville AFB, Arkansas, and Grissom AFB, Indiana, of their possible use as on-load sites for munitions and other items. (3)
- 12 October (U) ~~(S)~~ Two KC-135s from Pease AFB, New Hampshire, supported the deployment of two F-4 "Phantom" fighter aircraft to Lajes Air Base (AB), Azores, under Coronet East 35. (4)
- 13 October (U) ~~(S)~~ One KC-135 of the 384 Air Refueling Wing (AREFW), McConnell AFB, Kansas, supported the Coronet East movement of four F-4s from Nellis AFB, Nevada, to Seymour-Johnson AFB, North Carolina. (5)
- 13 October (U) ~~(S)~~ To support Peace Echo IV, Coronet East 47, Second Air Force formed a tanker task force (TTF) at Pease, commanded by Colonel Donald B. Shea, 45th Air Division (AD), Director of Operations (DO). The TTF contained 11 KC-135s of the 34 and 509 Air Refueling Squadrons (AREFSs) of Pease and deployed to Lajes. Two additional Pease tankers deployed
 The 13 KC-135s supported the movement of 12 F4Es, to Lajes. (6)
- 14 October (U) ~~(S)~~ Headquarters USAF designated Barksdale as one of several Continental United States (CONUS) bases to support airlift of military supplies for Israel by C-5 and C-141 transport aircraft of the Military Airlift Command (MAC) under Project 9DD. (7)

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14 October (S) Seven KC-135s of the 301AREFW, operating out of Lockbourne AFB, Ohio, plus an additional 301st tanker, deploying from Lockbourne to Lajes, supported the movement of eight F4s to Lajes under Coronet East 51. (8)

14 October (S) Four Pease KC-135s of the Lajes TTF, under the command of Colonel Robert C. Chapman, 380th Bomb Wing (BMW) DO, also supported F4 movements to Lajes. (9)

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14 October (S) Under Coronet East 35A, two Pease tankers, operating out of Lajes and five KC-135s of the supported the deployment of six F4s to their Israeli destination. (10)

14 October (S) A KC-135 of the 920AREFS, Wurtsmith AFB, Michigan, deployed to Lajes, carrying the War Readiness Spares Kit (WRSK). (11)

15 October (S) A Pease tanker returned to its home base from Lajes, carrying Colonel Shea, who was to take command of an expanded Pease TTF to support F4 movements. The TTF consisted of 10 tankers and 20 crews, all from Second Air Force units as follows: (12)

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15 October (U) Colonel Chapman, Lajes TTF Commander advised SAC and Second Air Force that his KC-135s had flown their first missions 22 hours after arriving on the morning of 14 October. He noted some potential problems, including poor communications, limited demineralized water service, not enough electrical power, a deficiency in MC-1A air compressors, a limited number of aerospace ground equipment (AGE) technicians, no capability to reproduce papers for mission packages, and some aircraft either approaching or exceeding phase inspection time. He reported, however that only the communications and mission packages problems were serious enough to affect the mission over a short time and that Second Air Force and SAC help to the TTF to date had been "... outstanding and is greatly appreciated." (13)

15 October (S) By this date, Israel had lost nearly aircraft, primarily through SA-6 action. That number included over 25 F4s. In the F4 resupply, supported by Second Air Force tankers, eight F4s were at Lajes and 14 were to their destination. (14)

16 October (S) On Peace Echo/Coronet East 45, four more F4s deployed from the McDonnell Douglas Corporation, St. Louis, Missouri, to Lajes, supported by four KC-135s of the 41AREFS, that flew in and out of their Griffiss AFB, New York, home base. (15)

16 October (S)

16 October (S) On Peace Echo IV/Coronet East 53, 10 F4s deployed to Lajes. Tanker support under Second Air Force tasking included two 301AREFW KC-135s, operating out of Lockbourne; two 301AREFW tankers, deploying from Lockbourne to Lajes; two Loring KC-135s, operating out of Loring AFB, Maine (one aborted into Lajes); two Loring tankers, deploying to Lajes; four Pease KC-135s, operating out of Pease (one aborted into Lajes); and one Pease KC-135, deploying to Lajes. (17)

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16 October (S) Second Air Force started providing special support to the Lajes TTF, which included selected AGE and support personnel. Also, SAC requested assistance of the Tactical Air Command (TAC) in resolving communications problems at Lajes. (18)

16 October (U) The Second Air Force Logistics Plans Division tasked the 380BMW, Plattsburgh AFB, New York, to provide mission control aircraft (MCA) equipment and the 99BMW, Westover AFB, Massachusetts, the 42BMW, Loring, and the 2BMW, Barksdale, to provide support personnel for the Pease TTF. (19)

16 October (S) By the end of this day, Second Air Force refueling support had helped deliver a total of 14 F4s to Lajes and 22 to Israel. (20)

17 October (S) On Coronet East 45A, four Phantoms reached their destination. Refueling support was by two tankers of the Lajes TTF and three of the (22)

17 October (S) Eight Coronet East ferry support tankers redeployed: Six to Pease, including two for TTF duty; one to Wurtsmith; and one to Loring. Four of those aircraft were near their phase inspection times. (23)

17 October (S) Second Air Force provided 10 KC-135s for Pease Echo IV/Coronet East 57 which moved eight F4s from Eglin AFB, Florida, to Lajes. Second Air Force participation from and back to home bases included two KC-135s of the 301AREFW and six Pease tankers. Rounding out the 10, two Pease tankers deployed to Lajes. (24)

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- 17 October (S) As directed by Second Air Force, the 911AREFS, Seymour-Johnson AFB, North Carolina, provided two KC-135s to support training of Navy A-4 "Skyhawk" aircraft crews in refueling procedures, preparatory to a later deployment of the Skyhawks to Israel. (25)
- 17 October (U) Colonel Chapman of the Lajes TTF advised the Second Air Force Logistics Plans Division that his major problem was communications. He needed five hand-held radios to communicate with flight line. He also needed some drogue equipment. He thanked Second Air Force for AGE that had arrived at Lajes. (26)
- 17 October (U) Later that day, the Lajes TTF told the Logistics Plans Division that it needed some electricians, adapters for engine stands, an engine trim kit, and some solvent paint. (27)
- 17 October (U) The Second Air Force Logistics Plans Division tasked the 305AREFW and the 301AREFW to provide personnel and equipment for the Lajes TTF. (28)
- 17 October (S) By the end of this day, Second Air Force tankers had helped deliver 26 F4s to destination and 10 were on Lajes. (29)
- 18 October (S) On Coronet East 53A, two F4Es moved from Lajes supported by two tankers of the Lajes TTF. (30) AF (b)(1)
- 18 October (S) A 305AREFW tanker began to deploy to Lajes, carrying drogue equipment. The aircraft stopped at Lockbourne and remained overnight for crew rest. (31)
- 18 October (S) The 911AREFS provided one KC-135 for A-4 refueling training support. (32)
- 18 October (S) The 380BMW, Plattsburgh AFB, New York, deployed one KC-135 to Pease as an addition to the Pease TTF. (33)

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18 October (U) By this date, Second Air Force had been able to provide the Lajes TTF with the following additional equipment and/or personnel, requested by Colonel Chapman on 14 October: (34)

18 October (S) By the end of this day, 28 F4s had reached Israel and eight were on Lajes. (35) R

19 October (S)

19 October (S) Four Pease tankers, flying out from and back to Pease, and two Pease KC-135s, flying from Pease to Lajes and back, supported the movement of 10 Skyhawks to Lajes on Coronet East 59. (37)

19 October (S) The 305AREFW tanker flew from Lockbourne to Lajes and back to Grissom and delivered the drogues to Lajes. (38)

19 October (S) The 911AREFS provided a tanker for A-4 practice refueling. (39)

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- 19 October (S) The Lajes TTF Commander, Colonel Chapman, reported that his operation had "smoothed out considerably". There was excellent progress in local command control communications, although message traffic was still a worry. With his force of nine KC-135s, he predicted that the TTF, with adequate logistics support, should be able to support eight air refueling sorties each day. He noted that morale was excellent. (40)
- 20 October (S) Under Coronet East 61, 12 Navy A-4Es deployed from the Norfolk Naval Air Station (NAS), Virginia, to Lajes. Refueling support was by six Pease KC-135s, four out of Pease and two out of Pease by way of Lajes. (41)
- 20 October (S) On Coronet East 35B, four F-4s deployed from Lajes to Israel, supported by five KC-135s of the Lajes TTF and three tankers of the (42)
- 20 October (S) The 911AREFS support A-4 refueling practice with one tanker. (43)
- 20 October (S) By the end of this day, 32 F-4s had been delivered to Israel, four of the Phantoms were on Lajes, as were 12 A-4s. Ten of the Navy Skyhawks had deployed from Lajes to the U. S. S. Franklin D. Roosevelt, an aircraft carrier. (44)
- 21 October (S) The 10 Skyhawks that moved to the U. S. S. Franklin D. Roosevelt were carried to Israel. (45)
- 21 October (S) On Coronet East 63, 16 A-4s deployed to Lajes. Tanker support was by six Pease KC-135s, operating from the home base, and three Pease tankers, flying by way of Lajes. (46)
- 21 October (S) Four Phantoms deployed to Lajes on Coronet East 57, supported by two 301AREFW tankers (Lockbourne-to-Lockbourne), three Plattsburgh tankers (home station-to-home station), and one Plattsburgh tanker (Plattsburgh-to-Lajes-to-Plattsburgh). (47)
- 21 October (S) For the fifth straight and final day, the 911AREFS supported A-4 air refueling practice, this time with one KC-135. (48)

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- 21 October (S) Twelve more A-4s deployed from Lajes to the U. S. S. Franklin D. Roosevelt. (49)
- 21 October (S) By the end of this day, eight F-4s were on Lajes and 32 had reached Israel. Sixteen A-4s were on Lajes, 12 aboard the U. S. S. Franklin D. Roosevelt, and 10 had reached Israel. (50)
- 22 October (S) On Coronet East 53C, four F4s reached their final destination, supported by two KC-135s of the Lajes TTF and (51)
- 22 October (S) On Coronet East 57A, three F4s reached Israel, but one suffered an air abort. Refueling support was by two KC-135s of the Lajes TTF and (52)
- 22 October (S) Coronet East 57B deployed on F-4 to its final destination. Refueling support was by two tankers of the Lajes TTF and (53)
- 22 October (S) Twelve A-4s moved aboard the U. S. S. Franklin D. Roosevelt to Israel, and an additional 12 deployed from Lajes to that carrier. (54)
- 22 October (S) By the end of this day, 40 F-4s had reached Israel and none remained on Lajes. Of the Skyhawks, 22 had reached Israel, 12 were aboard the U. S. S. Franklin D. Roosevelt, and four were on Lajes. (55)
- 23 October (S) Headquarters SAC directed return of the Lajes TTF to the CONUS on 24 and 25 October and released the Pease TTF. (56)
- 23 October (S) Tankers of the Pease TTF redeployed to their respective home stations. (57)
- 23 October (S) The last four A-4s deployed from Lajes to the U. S. S. Franklin D. Roosevelt after the carrier had delivered 12 more Skyhawks to their final destination. The total A-4s delivered to Israel by the close of this day was 34. (58)

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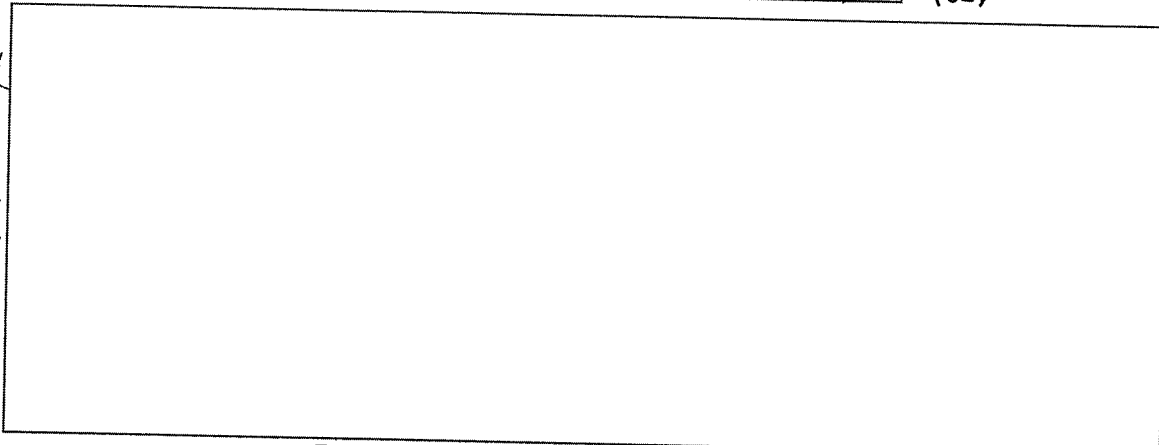

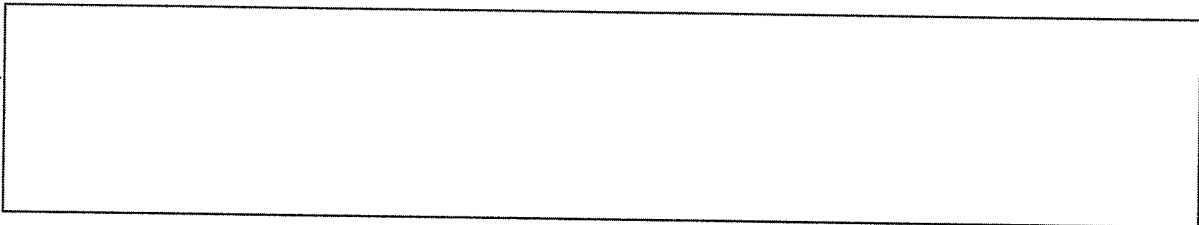

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

1. THE LOCAL SUPPORT BEING PROVIDED THIS TASK FORCE HAS BEEN OUTSTANDING. I FEEL THAT WE ARE OBTAINING SOME STABILITY AND THE OPERATION HAS SMOOTHED OUT CONSIDERABLY. THE LOCAL WING COMMANDER (B/GEN COMSTOCK) HAS MADE THE FOLLOWING REQUESTS.

A. DUE TO EXTREMELY LIMITED RAMP SPACE AND HOUSING HE REQUESTS THAT OUR TRANSIENT KC-135 AIRCRAFT BE GIVEN A FAST TURN AROUND AND RETURNED TO THE CONUS. HE RELIZES THAT THE CREW REST PROBLEM AFTER LONG MISSIONS COULD PREVENT A FAST TURN AROUND. HOWEVER HE SUGGESTS THAT THE FERRY CREW CONCEPT BE UTILIZED.
