2. THE FULLOWING INFORMATION WAS FOR THE MUST PART PROVIDED BY GOOD FORTUNE, ONLY FOUR FRENCH TECHNICIANS WERE IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF THE OSIRAK REACTOR WHEN IT WAS ATTACKED BY ISPAELI AIRCRAFT, ONE OF THEM WHO WAS "DOWN VERY DEEP" WAS KILLED BY FUMES. A NUMBER OF IRAQIS WERE INJURED BUT

ALL ARE NOW DUT OF HOSPITAL.

3. RADIDACTIVE FUEL RODS HAD NOT BEEN INSERTED INTO THE REACTOR BUT WERE STORED IN A SEPARATE FACILITY WHICH WAS LOCKED. GEISER COUNTER CHECK DISCLOSED NO RAUIDACTIVITY

IN THE AREA.
