

(S//REL) Good morning, sir, [REDACTED]. The following is a brief overview of our initial operational assessment for Operation GLOWING SYMPHONY. The overall operational assessment framework consists of the task accomplishment framework for evaluating how well we're executing the operation, and the operational effectiveness framework that will assess how well the operation is achieving the intended effects.

(U//FOUO) The focus this morning is our assessment of task accomplishment thus far. I will not be briefing the operational effectiveness portion of the framework because we are still collecting data and intelligence reflections.

(U//FOUO) The framework is broken down by phase from the CONOP, with supporting measures of performance and indicators. Actual numerical data for each indicator is shown in blue. After each indicator description are the Coalition partners represented in the data. The stop light circle next to each indicator assesses that particular measure. The gray circles represent indicators that are not important for assessing task accomplishment, but still contribute to the understanding of Coalition activities. The full legend is shown on the bottom left of the slide.

(TS//SI//REL) Overall, we assess the task execution of OGS as green, or successful. All evaluated indicators are green, except for [REDACTED] [REDACTED] which was assessed as amber. 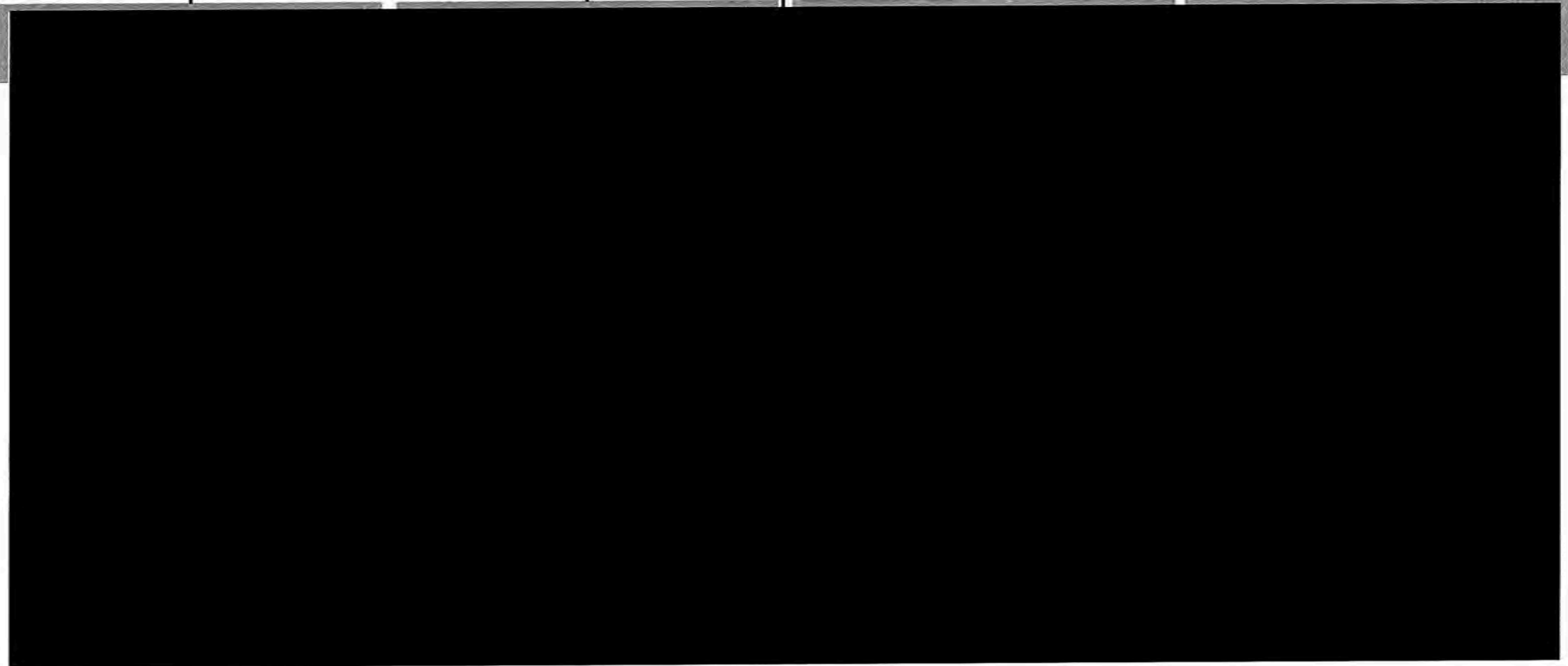

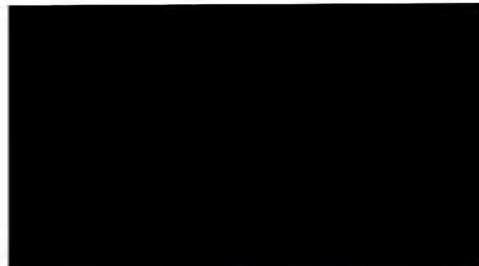

### **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

- (U) Operation Assessment - A continuous process that supports decision making by measuring the progress toward accomplishing a task, creating a condition, or achieving an objective. (JDN 1-15)
- (U) Assessment
  - A continuous process that measures the overall effectiveness of employing joint force capabilities during military operations. (JP 3-0)
  - Determination of the progress toward accomplishing a task, creating a condition, or achieving an objective. (JP 3-0)
- (U) Battle Damage Assessment - The estimate of damage composed of physical and functional damage assessment, as well as target system assessment, resulting from the application of lethal or nonlethal military force. (JP 3-0)
- (U) Measure of Performance (MOP) - A criterion used to assess friendly actions that is tied to measuring task accomplishment. (JP 3-0)
- (U) Measure of Effectiveness (MOE) - A criterion used to assess changes in system behavior, capability, or operational environment that is tied to measuring the attainment of an end state, achievement of an objective, or creation of an effect. (JP 3-0)

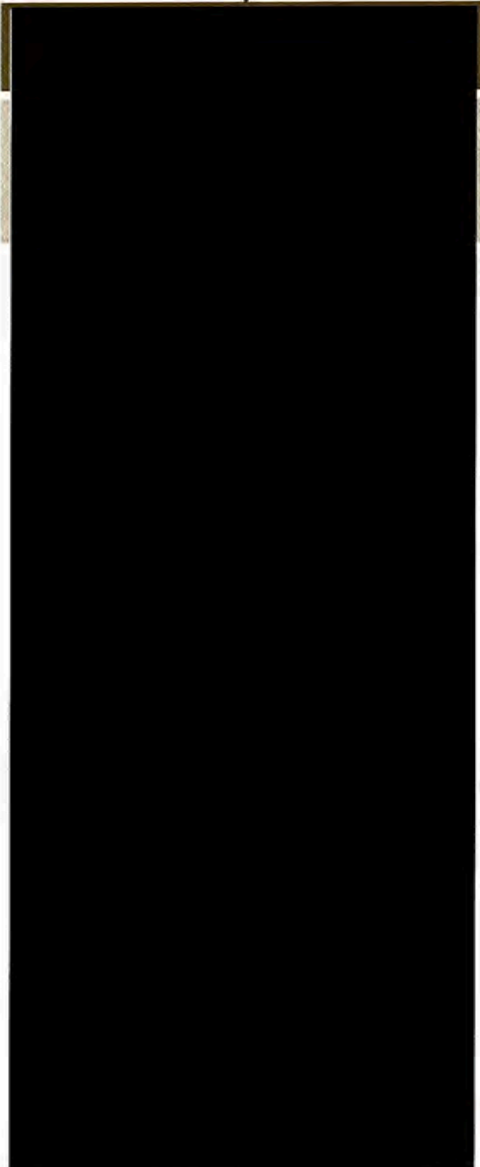

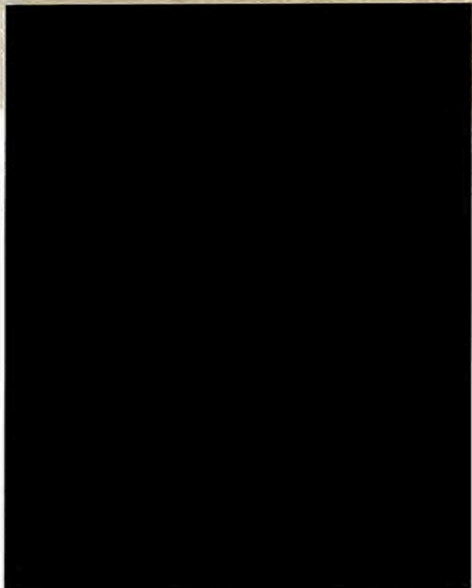
