- THERE HAS BEEN A SIGNIFICANT AMOUNT OF DEBATE IN THE MOSCOW PRESS ABOUT WHAT REALLY HAPPENED IN IN A SPEECH TO THE RUSSIAN STATE DUMA LAST WEEK, DUMA DEPUTY STANISLAV GOVORUKHIN, CHAIRMAN OF A SPECIAL PARLIAMENTARY COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE THE CHECHEN CRISIS, STRONGLY DEFENDED THE MILITARY'S ACTIONS IN SAMASHKI. BASING HIS REMARKS ON A RECENT VISIT TO THE REGION, HE ACCUSED HUMAN RIGHTS ORGANIZATIONS OF FALSIFYING THE EVIDENCE FOR POLITICAL PURPOSES. HIS REPORT WAS FAR DIFFERENT IN TONE FROM THAT OF DUMA DEPUTY ANATOLIY SHABAD, WHO VISITED SAMASHKI ON APRIL 12 AND REPORTED THAT RUSSIAN TROOPS HAD CARRIED OUT A MASSACRE. A GROUP OF FEDERATION COUNCIL DEPUTIES WHO VISITED SAMASHKI TOLD A PRESS CONFERENCE ON APRIL 25 THAT "UNJUSTIFIED AND CRUEL ACTIONS AGAINST CIVILIANS" TOOK PLACE IN SAMASHKI AND THAT EVIDENCE WOULD BE PASSED TO THE PROCURATOR GENERAL'S OFFICE.
