SUNDAY OCTOBER BACHE (DD 470) UNITED STATES SHIP (Mania)

Steaming in company with TU 83.2.3 composed of USS RANDOLPH (CVS 15), USS EATON (DD 510), USS WALLER (Dr 466) and USS CONWAY (DD 507). Operating at sea in accordance with CTG 83.2 231248Z. Ships are formed in a concentric circular screen. This ship in Rescue Destroyer station 2. Flight operations course 070, speed 12kts. When on station the ghide USS RANDOLPH, bears 160, distance 2500 yards. OTC is CTG 83.2/COMCARDIV 16 embarked in USS RANDOLPH. Screen commander is CTE 83.2.22/C MDFSDIV 282 embarked in USS EATON. Material condition YOKE and Readiness condition 4 are set. 0040 Flight operations course altered to 070. 0045 c/c to 090. 0047 c/s to 10kts. 0049 Proceeding to station one of a concentric circular screen. Guide is USS RANDOLPH, bears 180, distance 4000 yards when on station. 0055 On station. 0130 c/c to 200. 0157 c/c to 230. 0240 Maneuvering totake Rescue Destroyer station 2. Flight operations course 060, speed lokts. Guide is USS RANDOLPH, bears 150, range 2500 yards when on station. 0252 c/c to 145. 0256 On station, c/c to 060. 0312 c/c to 150. 0333 c/c to 060. 0353 Maneuvering to take station 1 of a concentric screen. Guide is USS RANDOLPH, bears 180, distance 4000 yards when on station. 0356 c/c to 150. 0400 On station.

Steaming as before. 0434 Proceeding to take Rescue Destroyer station #2, bearing 330, distant 2500 yards from USS RANDOLPH. 0438 On station, c/o to 060 while conducting flight operations.
0447 c/c to 050. 0452 c/c to 040. 0456 c/s to 13kts. 0459 c/s to 18kts. 0501 Completed
flight operations; Resuming previous station. 0505 c/c to 130. 0515 On station. 0516 c/s to
12kts. 0527 c/c to 085; USS J.P. KEN MEDY (DD 850) joined the formation and was assigned screen station #4. 0625 Conducted bathythermograph observation. 0632 Observation complete. 0658 Advanced all clocks 1 hour to conform to +4 zone time. 0659 Stationed the helicopter detail.

Steaming as before. 0812 Received onboard Roman Catholic Chaplain from HELO #60. 0819 Transferred Protestant Chaplain to HELO 460. 0830 Maneuvering to take station 1000 yards astern of USS RANDOTPH. 0945 Mustered the crew on station. Absentees: SULLIVAN, D.A., 588 53 94, TMSN, USN, absent since 0500, 11 October 1962. 1037 c/s to 15kts. Proceeding to standby station. 1040 c/s to 12kts. 1049 c/s to 17kts. Commenced approach to USS RANDOTPH. Ease course is 085, speed 12kts. 1054 Alongside. Commenced taking on fuel. 1106 Transferred Roman Catholic Chaplain to USS RANDOLPH. 1138 All lines clear, c/s to 22kts. c/s to 340. Proceeding to join SAV Bravo 12 miles distant.
