MEMORANDUM TO THE FILE

Subject: [REDACTED] H-B/3

1. On Thursday, 14 January 1954, the writer discussed the request of the Technical Branch in connection with a visit by a contact offer to the [REDACTED] requested, in view of the fact that no one had been able to successfully approach the [REDACTED] that the request be dropped for the time being pending further study of the problem. The writer agreed and told [REDACTED] she could instruct the Contact representatives to make no further efforts in this direction for the present at least.

The actual problem in this case was that the Contact representative originally scheduled to visit the [REDACTED] had reported that [REDACTED] be turned over to a special contact of the Medical Division in [REDACTED]. The writer, before permitting this information to be passed to the Medical Division contact, discussed the matter with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and it was agreed that rather than spreading the information regarding [REDACTED] interest, it would be better to withhold this information and attempt solution in another direction. At this time, the writer was asked [REDACTED] to see if further arrange ments could be made. Apparently [REDACTED] was unable to make further arrangements.
