1. [redacted] briefed [redacted] concerning the subject meeting as follows: [redacted] is now the successor to [redacted] in the [redacted], in charge of [redacted]. [redacted] is now a fellow member of the [redacted] with [redacted].

2. [redacted] received a file from [redacted] which related to the interrogation project. Nothing has been added to this file since 1950, and there was a note therein that some project material had been sent to [redacted]. [redacted] stated that he would investigate as to where this material was and why it had not been returned to the files of the [redacted]. In answer to [redacted] inquiry, [redacted] informed him that there was a panel working under [redacted] on the development of a domestic research program. [redacted] informed him also that he would take up the matter of [redacted] participation at the first suitable opportunity with [redacted]. However he did not wish to initiate [redacted] activity except through that channel. With reference to funds and personnel, [redacted] informed [redacted] there was no shortage of funds, however, there is a shortage of qualified personnel.
