A SUBJECTS (Conversations with 19-20 October 1951

l. a met with and in the OO Office is at-10:00 a.m., 19 October. and were briefed on the general progress being made in the various research fields of the project and appeared to be considerably heartened over the program as outlined.

A 2: asked to look in on the work going on at in connection with rapid selection techniques. Will report on its bearing, if any, on our project and the scope, techniques, etc., of the work.

advised of the plans for a thorough approach to all methods of detecting deception.

agreed to contact as soon as he returns from (early in November) and put in touch with before he takes any action in the field.

on his conversations with a would get a report from continue to work on the general aspects of psychological techniques for interrogations. (It has been generally agreed by psychologists and psychiatrists both within and outside CLA that a psychological approach to the interviewee, regardless of the techniques used, is the most important part of the problem.)

agreed to arrange for all requests for travel and requests for reimburgement for travel originating from the panel members to be sent to the sent to the who will arrange for the details.

6. It was agreed that would maintain contact with the panel through at least every two-weeks in order to benefit by new ideas turned up by them and to obtain their ideas on projects in progress.
