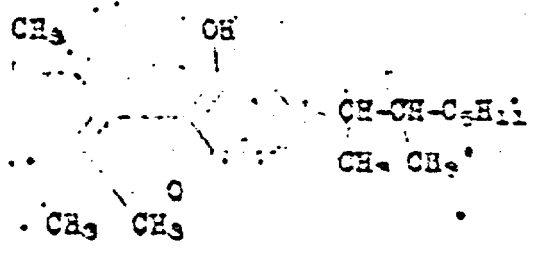

Yes, the 1,2-dimethyl leptic analog is the material studied by Loewe except it is a mixture of isomers; that is, it may contain compounds with the methyl group in various positions and, because of the number of asymmetric carbon atoms, there may be several stereo isomers present. The formula is as follows:
