C 1. Reur telephone request, we made contact with Mr. [redacted], concerning B  
the following:

- a. 20,000 [redacted] 8 mg tablets I
- b. 20,000 [redacted] 4 mg tablets
- c. 200 x 10 cc vials [redacted] 5 mg per cc I
- d. plus sufficient placebos

F B for the purpose of conducting a double blind study on their effectiveness at a mental hospital in [redacted] Mr. [redacted] was C most cooperative and agreed to make the material available at no cost to the Agency. He was assured that a competent study would be conducted and that the results would be made available to [redacted] for their use.

A 2. It would be possible to have the [redacted] in a few days, I but the placebos are not immediately available and will have to be made up special. This may take a week to 10 days. We will be notified when all is ready and will pick up the material and send to [redacted] through the usual facilities.

B 3. In addition to the material, [redacted] will include C directions and precautions for its use, with full description of side reactions encountered with this material. As he stated, these reactions have been few; but he would not want to have anything reflect on the US in the event they did occur without previous knowledge - neither would he want any reflection cast on [redacted] reputation should this occur. As a further precaution, and in addition to all the above material, he will include an antidote to be administered should the side reactions occur.

4. We look forward to seeing the results of the study. By the way, this is a tranquilizer similar to reserpine but an improvement and has an appropriate name [redacted] I
