MEMORANDUM FOR: The Record

SUBJECT : [REDACTED]
Members of the WSP

1. Reference is made to the memoranda submitted by Acting Chief, Special Operations Branch, dated 13 October and 20 October 1967. The referents reported the results of a surveillance conducted upon the premises located at [REDACTED] an active member of the WSP. While a meeting upon the above premises was in progress an unidentified female was observed leaving the premises entering a rental vehicle and proceeding to [REDACTED]. A list of the registered tenants in the [REDACTED] apartment building disclosed the names of individuals not previously known to this office. This list is found in the previous referent.

2. An interview of an individual who was present during the alluded to meeting was conducted during which it was determined that [REDACTED] departed the meeting before its completion and that she [REDACTED]. The description of [REDACTED] as provided by the surveillances is consistent with that of someone who personally knows [REDACTED]. Two of the residents of the [REDACTED] address bear given names of [REDACTED].

3. In view of the foregoing, it is believed that [REDACTED] was operating the vehicle on the night in question and that one of the [REDACTED].
