The following are direct statements made by [redacted] at a Black United Front (BUF) meeting held 6 August 1968, at 2263 Mt. View Street, SE, Washington, D.C. This meeting lasted for approximately 1 1/2 hours:

"Get a new police system."

"Have black policemen patrol black communities."

"All members of the police force will be residents of the District of Columbia."

"Get those southern hill-billies off the police force."

"Lower restrictions on police examination."
