OPERATION MERRIMACK - Special Report

It has been reliably reported that a black militant type dressed in the outfit of the Poor Peoples Campaign has personally contacted store owners in the 14th and Florida Avenue area and advised them to close their stores on Monday (20 May 1968) or else. The description of this individual fits [REDACTED] a 25 year-old colored male, local member of SNCC.
