OPERATION MERRIMACK SITUATION REPORT
SPECIAL INFORMATION

The information contained herein was advanced by informants of previous proven reliability.

Reference is made to the memorandum submitted 15 November 1967, relative to a composite of information-pertaining to Operation MERRIMACK. Particular reference is made to paragraph 4 wherein was noted that the Soviet Woman's Committee was sending two delegates to the United States and requested assistance and support from the WSP.

At a recent Steering Committee meeting of the WSP, [redacted] the two Russian women during their stay at Washington, D.C. The Russian women are expected on 16 January 1968, but attempts are being made to have them arrive earlier so as to be present during the Jeannette RANKIN Brigade demonstration scheduled on 15 January 1968.
