

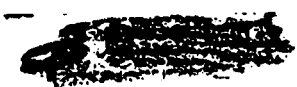

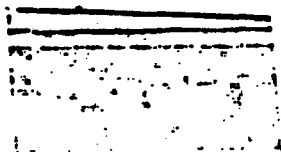
PROJECT MERRIMACK - Special Report

On 29 October 1963 at 1830 hours the CBW Mid-Atlantic Committee on Fort Detrick meeting was held at the home of ~~Redacted name~~ Washington, D. C.

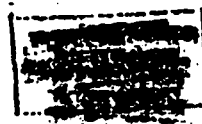
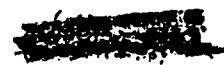
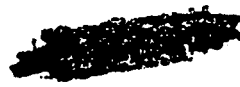
