NSA Officers Discussion of CIA on Local Detroit Television News

1. Michael Wood and Edward Schwartz appeared on 12 March 1967 on the local Lou Gordon Show on WKBD Television in Detroit. Wood during 1965-66 was director in charge of fund raising for the National Student Association and it was he who provided the information for the Reports story on CIA. Schwartz is the current vice-president for national affairs of NSA.

2. During the segment which lasted for about 15 minutes, Schwartz denied a story printed by Drew Pearson on 9 March 1967 in which Schwartz is quoted as saying that if NSA blasted CIA the draft deferments of some of its officers would probably be lifted. Wood admitted he is currently subsisting on income derived from giving lectures at various universities on CIA.
