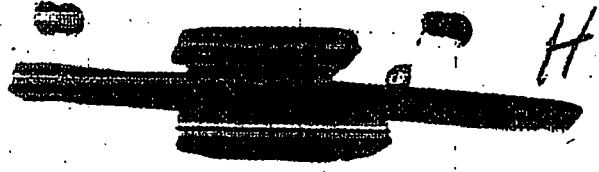
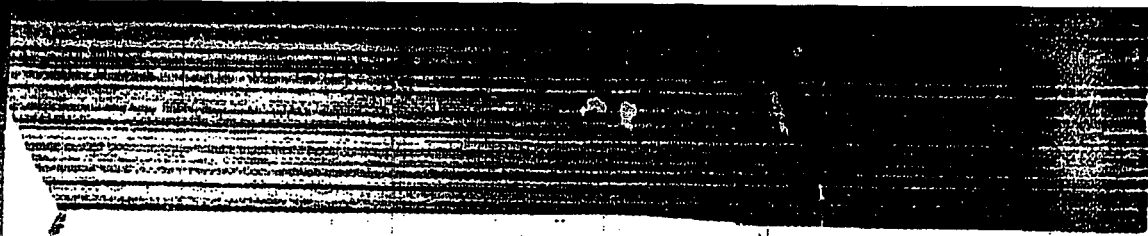

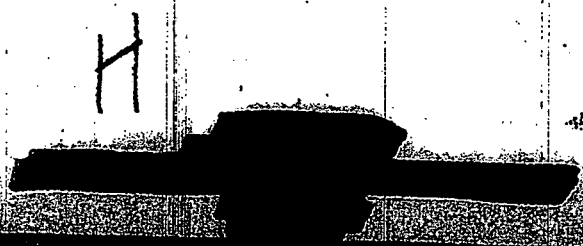

Students for a Democratic Society (SDS) had persuaded the group, after their arrival in New York City, not to appear at the NSA Congress. However, on their arrival at Kansas State, the foreign students stated that the contacts with SDS had been planned, and that although SDS had spoken critically about NSA and its past domination by CIA, they had not tried to dissuade the foreign students from attending the Congress, but had encouraged the trip as a fact-finding mission. ⁶
