Dear Sir/Madam

After contacting the CAA and NATS on the evening of the 17th Sept 2009 I was referred to the MoD and having spoken to a representative of the MoD I was asked to file a report to the low flying dept of the MoD.

Firstly I am not simply an un educated member of the public with little understanding of aviation I am a former Member of Section 140 nical Aircrew and flew as a Flight Loadmaster and Flight Mechanic operating from the flight deck from Section 40 and briefly continued flying freelance as a Flight Loadmaster & Flight Mechanic. Additionally I trained as a pilot in Section 140 Upper Heyford USAF's Aero Club in Oxfordshire. I am also a former Flight Lieutenant in the Section 40 was a member of Section 40 at RAF Odiham and lastly commanded the RAF Section Section 40 I have gained a total of 3000 hours in the air in one capacity or another.

On the evening of the seventeenth September 2009. I was standing on the patio of my back garden with two friends having a cigarette brake. The area I live in is on the edge of town and is semi rural and is not particularly affected by light pollution as I live in Section 40 Worthing West Sussex Section 40 around 21:40 I noticed an extremely bright star like light in the sky it looked like a bright star and was the brightest light in the sky. The single white light was travelling at the sort of speed I would expect a commercial aircraft travelling below FL100 and I estimated that its altitude was between 6000ft and FL100 but no high than that. The heading was around 120 to 140 and its speed was between 180 kts and no faster than 250knts at the time it was flying straight and level. The aircraft made no sound what so ever, there were no high bypass gas turbine jet engines or the sound of helicopter blades turning which I would normally expect to hear from a helicopter. We regularly get the local police helicopter flying over the house at night time and it was not making the sound of a twin squirrel helicopter which is the local aircraft type used by Sussex police.

I am always sceptical about such things as "UFO's" However there was no anti collision beacon lights no strobe lights or navigation lights just a single ball of brilliant white high candela large ball of light and it was not any form of commercial aircraft or conventional military aircraft. Having established in my mind that this was not a normal type of aircraft what so ever and did not display any normal forms of required navigation lighting or viewable fuselage. All three of us then witnessed the following:

The aircraft continued to fly at about 180knts along the heading of about 120 and then started to climb vertically there was no visible change attitude of the aircraft it simply started to climb upwards at a tremendous speed way beyond any military aircraft, and within less than 10 seconds or so the white ball of light which had shown so brightly in the night sky was at an altitude well above that of any commercial aircraft or UK military aircraft in fact it disappeared at that point it was now a dim moving light which

disappeared in to a faint light and was gone. I'm no astronaut but I am interested in space travel and I would have said that the light was leaving the atmosphere of our planet.

All three of us witnessed this first light and within the next three to five minutes at around 21:45 a second ball of light appeared again on a heading of around 130 degrees and behaved in a the same way as the first again it had no navigation lights or anti collision beacon or strobes just a single ball of white light this seemed to be flying at around 6,000ft and was steadily climbing at a more conventional air speed one would expect from a commercial aircraft. An as it reached around FL100 the aircraft "Craft" made an abrupt turn which was completed much quicker than could be achieved in a commercial or military aircraft and seemed to be on a new heading of roughly 160 to 180 degrees and then like the other craft rapidly climbed tens of thousands of feet in around fifteen seconds. The sky was cavok and the light ended up getting fainter and fainter until it appeared to have reached space.

I have seen a similar bright light before however the last time I saw such a light was in the summer of 2005 it travelled directly over my home and passed over my neighbours roof and when I looked up again realising that it made no sound and had no navigation lights which was seconds later I looked for it expecting to see it as I placed myself in a clear view to see the craft only seconds later it was gone.

Now I have no idea what you plan to do with this report if anything at all but I state for the records that the information I have provided is the truth.

Good evening.

This morning, I tried 3 times to call your published telephone number, 01494 496254, but the automated response system advised that there was no-one to take the call, nor could a message be left.

On Saturday evening, I parked my car in Chatham, Kent at 19:22 and my partner went to get a ticket. I looked up over a building and saw two orange balls of light approaching relatively slowly from a northerly direction. From my viewpoint, I estimated them to be about ½ mile away and at about 2000-3000 ft. One ball of light was leading, with the other behind it and keeping track on its port side. A third ball of light then appeared, also from the same direction. The first two seemed to stop their forward motion, hover for a second, then turned and climbed away in a west to north-westerly direction at an approximate angle of 45 degrees. A few seconds later, the third ball did precisely the same. The entire incident was over in about 30 seconds, with my partner witnessing the departure of the third 'ball'. There was no sound of any engines, nor were there navigation or strobe lights.

I did manage to get one photograph of the departing 3rd 'ball' using the camera on my cell phone, but it is very indistinct.

I am Ex Royal Air Force (Service no Section 42nd have considerable experience with most of the Bomber and Fighter aircraft

dating back to the 1960's. I have worked with military aircraft until I retired a few years ago, so have a very good idea as to

what can be classified as UFO, Military or weather related sightings.

I have tried several times to report the following to a Ministry Of Defense Official both via the internal military

phone numbers beginning 95 & 96 and the civilian 24hr line 01494 496254 to no avail. So am sending this email

for your attention as a matter of urgency.

On Saturday 24th September 2009 between 21.55hrs and 22.05hrs, I and my Wife witnessed a constant stream

of about 15 to 20 very bright orange lights spaced about half a mile apart and in a perfectly straight line traveling

from the South West toward the North East.

They were at a height of about 20,000 feet and kept a very precise distance between each other. The first of these lights came to a stop whist the second light came up closer to it and also stopped.

While motionless in the sky, these first two lights started to fade until they could no longer be seen. As the first two vanished from sight so another of these orange lights moved into the same area and stopped.

It was joined by the fourth orange light and that too started to fade until it could no longer be seen. This whole process continued until all of the orange lights had disappeared. (all in exactly the same area.)

In all, this process took about ten minutes from start to finish.

During this time I had got hold of my binoculars to see if I could get a better view of these lights, but

could not see through the very bright and intense orange glow, so was unable to determine the source.

Most regrettably I did not have any camera to hand so could not capture the events on film.

Also during this "Spectacular Parade" of lights a Jet Airliner flew underneath them on a course from

to West (part of the commercial air corridor) so must have had a close up view. The Aircraft was flying at

about 15,000 feet. Apart from this airliner we heard no sound whatsoever from any of these bright

orange lights.

The sky was completely clear with no cloud and the stars were clearly visible.

In my view these sightings fit very definitely into the UFO category.

Bearing in mind that such precision in their maneuvering and flight paths would indicate intelligent control, this sighting should warrant immediate investigation by the Ministry Of Defense.

Local newspapers have apparently had no reports from the general public in relation to this event. Neither have I found any report about these bright orange lights on the Internet.

Last night 12 September 2009 at 1030 pm we saw at least 20 bright orange lights, low in the sky moving fairly fast and completely silent following a similar trajectory one after the other over Henley in Arden. A car stopped to say he had seen at least 35 of them all following each other exactly. Any ideas?

This has started to ring alarm bells as it points to the possibility that our defense systems could be under scrutiny from an unknown source and may become vulnerable to some form of action from that unknown source.

I would be very grateful if you could take this matter seriously and launch an investigation into these events.(I say events due to the report on 13th September

2009 by Section 40 who has witnessed an almost identical event just a week or so before the incident that my Wife and I had witnessed)





Please find attached in depth description of incident on 20/09/2009 at approx 1845 hours. I would be more than happy to give anykind of interview. These were real, there is no doubt about that.

At approximately 1835 hrs I was contacted by my mother asking if I had seen the colourful light in the sky. I went outside but nothing could be seen, however I decided to sit out for a while At approx 1845 two Orbs of light rose from behind the nearby houses. One was distinctly ahead of the other. I would say these objects were no more than half a mile away if that, perhaps even a few hundred metres. They rose in the western sky.

The lead UFO rose quicker than the other but extremely gracefully, heading toward my direction. Instantly I knew what I was seeing, this was no ordinary craft. Suddenly to my amazement the lead craft stopped dead in mid air! It then backtracked for a second or two, then it rose directly vertically approx 200 - 500 metres again stopping dead. There was absolutely no noise whatsoever and we live in silence in Mulbarton. It appeared the lead craft was almost waiting for the other which as it came within 50 metres both craft headed off into the distance rising up eventually through the clouds.

The best description of the ufos is as follows.

The lead craft was slightly brighter than the first.

Each was a colour that I will describe as orange, however they were more than that As they were so close at one stage I could see that they were made up of many merging colours that radiated outward. They were obviously emitting an extreme energy but in total silence. I would also say that gravity did not appear to affect them. They left no vapour trail.

As they rose from such a very low level I believe it possible that they may of actually been on the ground nearby. I live very close to a very wooded area surrounded by fields.

My wife is the biggest alien doubter of all time, however at the first sighting I shouted through our kitchen window to her to come quick. She to saw them and was amazed at what she was seeing.

These were defiantly ufos, no doubt whatsoever. They were not aircraft with lights on head on. There is only one Venus, which was clearly visible anyhow. Also Venus is further away than a few hundred yards. And Chinese Lanterns is laughable.

My biggest regret is that I could not video the event. I believe the video would have been the utmost confirmation of the existence of ufos ever. Nothing on Earth is coloured like that. Nothing can stop dead in the sky. Nothing floats like that in total silence. These were real and I just want everyone to know it.



Good morning,

About 2202 hours on Saturday 19 September 2009 my wife was closing the blinds in our house. Our window generally faces the west. I was asleep on the couch when she awakened me and alerted me to 'lights' in the sky.

I looked out of the window and saw approx 8 - 10 lights in the sky. At first they appeared like the very bright fireworks which are fired vertically into the sky.

However we both went outside into our street and witnessed something that we have no explanation for.

The lights were a good distance away from us, maybe as far away as Motherwell - Glasgow. They were higher than the the flight level of a plane heading for Glasgow.

In no particular pattern, one by one they flew in a direct line towards the east and nearly straight above us. They stayed at the same flight level and there was no engine sound. As we both looked up there was no image that we could identify a plane shape, but how could there be as there was no engine noise!

Once they flew high over us, which lasted about 5 minutes, they either disappeared over the Forth (village) area or the lights faded as there may have been cloud cover, albeit very light. It may have been due to the speed that they picked up, which made them disapper out of our viewing range.

This experience will last for us forever, we cannot think of any explanation known to us. I reported it to Real Radio Newsroom in Glasgow - didn't treat me seriously but I expect that.

It was not the Red Arrows, not Chinesed Lanterns, no aircraft I know (no engine noise), no

flashing lights, speed was very significant.

PS I have very short footage on my mobile of two lights.

If correspondence includes a specific request for recorded information then it should be treated under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000, even though the Act is not specifically mentioned. You should inform Parliamentary Branch, who will close the case down on the Parliamentary Toolkit. The correspondence should then be logged on the

Access to Information Toolkit and you should consult and comply with the separate FOI guidance from DG Info. If you are in any doubt as to whether a piece of correspondence should be treated as an FOI request, you should ask your FOI Focal Point or refer to the guidance produced by DG Info. Thank you for your email of 21 September, reporting an 'unidentified flying object', seen on 19 September over the New Forest. I have been asked to reply as this office is the focal point within the Ministry of Defence for correspondence relating to UFOs.

Firstly, it may be helpful if I explain that the Ministry of Defence (MoD) examines any reports of 'unidentified flying objects' it receives, solely to establish whether what was seen might have some defence significance; namely, whether there is any evidence that the United Kingdom's airspace might have been compromised by hostile or unauthorised air activity.

Unless there is evidence of a potential threat to the United Kingdom from an external source, and to date no UFO report has revealed such evidence, we do not attempt to identify the precise nature of each sighting reported to us. We believe that rational explanations, such as aircraft lights or natural phenomena, could be found for them if resources were diverted for this purpose, but it is not the function of the MoD to provide this kind of aerial identification service. It would be an inappropriate use of defence resources if we were to do so.

The MoD does not have any expertise or role in respect of 'UFO/flying saucer' matters or the question of the existence or otherwise of extraterrestrial life forms, about which it remains totally open-minded. I should add that to date, the MoD knows of no evidence which substantiates the existence of these alleged phenomena.

Firstly I've never seen or reported anything like this before so I'm not some serial nutjob (if that's relative) but thought you might like to hear about this and if you ever figure out what it was it'd be quite nice to hear back.

Basically my girlfriend (who can also confirm the sighting) and I went camping in the New Forest this weekend (Hollands Wood Campsite, SO42 7QH). I guestimate that between 22:00 and 23:00 there was something overhead that speaking relatively was going much too slow to be a meteor (shooting star) but was too high up to be a flare or firework. It was travelling at about the same speed as you'd expect an ordinary high altitude jet to be, but instead of the usual flashing landing lights of a plane it looked instead like a fireball.


I first saw the 'fireball' when it was about 11 O clock to the horizon through a gap in the foliage and it then travelled south south east for about 30 seconds. It burnt pretty brightly and then would burn out a little then appear to burn brightly again a few times before extinguishing about 30 seconds later (without going over the horizon or disappearing behind a tree). As far as I could tell there were no clouds around that night as we could see a few stars overhead through the trees. I genuinely thought we had witnessed a plane on fire and expected to get back today and read all about it on the news...

Obviously there was no such report (two other light aeroplane crashed the following day but nothing at that time) so without explanation I thought I'd look you guys up and make a report.

I'm happy to help if you require any further details (mobile Section 40 but that's about as much as I can think of, apart from the fact that there was no sound (ie: of a jet or anything) that we could make out.

Lanterns spark flare alert

THE coastguard received more than a dozen emergency calls after concerned members of the public mistook Chinese lanterns for distress flares.

Several lanterns, which rise into the air using a small flame, were let off in Ulverston on Saturday night.

But fearing the worst, between 12 and 15 people called the coastguard to report what they thought were emergency distress flares.

Rescue teams from the coastguard were not dispatched.

A spokesman for Liverpool Coastguard, which covers the Bardsea area, said: "Anyone can buy these things. They let them off at the coast and they get reported to us as red flares and UFOs. It is a bit of a pain to be honest."

The incident coincided with the annual Ulverston Lantern Festival.



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The finale of the festival is organised by the Ulverston Community Arts Network.

Member of the group Ness Wilson said: "It absolutely wasn't part of the festival. We didn't let Chinese lanterns off because the weather was so still. We didn't want those things to be landing in residential areas.

"They have started to become very domesticated instead of something used at special events.
