This letter is the final response to your April 27, 2016, Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Office of Intelligence and Analysis (I&A). You are requesting "a list, catalog or index of all reports issued in 2015 that contain the numbering system IA-0000-15 where -15 is the year of the report and 0000 is the number of the report which is updated sequentially. At a minimum, I respectfully request that the report should include the name or subject of the report and the report number."

A search of I&A records for documents responsive to your request produced a total of eighteen (18) pages. Based on the review of these documents, I&A is providing the following:

Exemption 1, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(3)

Exemption 7(E) protects all law enforcement information that "would disclose techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigation or prosecution, or would disclose guidelines for law enforcement investigations or prosecution if such disclosure could reasonably be expected to risk circumvention of the law." See 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(7)(E).

You have a right to appeal this response. Should you wish to do so, you must send your appeal and a copy of this letter, within 60 days of the date of this letter, to: Associate General Counsel (General Law), U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Washington, D.C. 20528, following the procedures outlined in the DHS regulations at 6 C.F.R. § 5.9. 
